Day 1

Ho Chi Minh City Arrival and Evening at Leisure

Stay: Hotel in Ho Chi Minh | Transport: Private car

You might choose to experience the vibrant pulse of Ho Chi Minh City's nightlife, perhaps by taking an optional motorbike tour to see the illuminated streets and local hotspots. Alternatively, consider attending a cultural performance like the A O Show Saigon for a captivating introduction to Vietnamese artistry.

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Day 2**Ho Chi Minh City Motorbike Exploration & Hidden Gems***Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Ho Chi Minh | Transport: Motorcycle*

Begin your day with an exciting half-day city tour of Ho Chi Minh, offering a unique perspective from the back of a local motorbike. You can choose a morning or afternoon departure (8:00-8:30 AM or 1:00-1:30 PM). Your journey will take you past significant French colonial architectural marvels such as the Notre Dame Cathedral and the historic Central Post Office, showcasing their intricate Gothic designs. You'll also admire the grand Saigon Opera House, an elegant structure reflecting Belle Époque aesthetics and Vietnam's past.

Continue your ride through the city, passing the Ho Chi Minh City People's Committee Head Office, once the city hall, before reaching the lively Nguyen Hue Walking Street, a prime spot for photography and people-watching. The tour then delves into some of Saigon's lesser-known treasures, including the poignant Thich Quang Duc monument, the fragrant Ho Thi Ky flower market, the ancient Thien Hau Pagoda, and the bustling Cambodian market. Experience the local rhythm with a walk through the Nguyen Thien Thuat Oldest Apartment complex, renowned for its diverse street food and authentic neighborhood culture. As the tour concludes, your motorbike will take you back to your hotel, passing by Nguyen Trai Street in District 5, famous for its array of fashion boutiques. The rest of the day is yours to relax or continue exploring the city at your own leisure, perhaps revisiting a favorite spot or discovering new ones.

Following breakfast, depart at 8:00 AM for a transfer to Cai Be, where your Mekong Delta adventure begins. Your first stop is a Com Candy Craft Village, offering insight into the traditional process of making candy nuggets, complete with samples of the freshly baked treats. Next, visit a local bee farm where you can enjoy refreshing honey tea and observe the daily routines of the garden residents.

From the bee farm, your guide will lead you to Tan Phong Islet. Here, you'll engage in a garden tour, sampling and even picking seasonal tropical fruits such as durian, rambutan, and longan directly from the trees. Later, visit a local home to experience a live performance of "Don Ca Tai Tu," a traditional Vietnamese folk music genre, accompanied by tea and a warm fruit welcome from your hosts. A tranquil rowing boat ride through narrow canals will then take you to the Mekong Ecolodge for check-in, followed by a delicious lunch at a nearby eatery.

The afternoon offers leisure time to relax or explore the Ecolodge's extensive fruit and flower gardens, where you are welcome to pick and enjoy fruits at no charge. Later, engage in a unique local activity: "ditch fishing hook," using traditional tools to catch fish. 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shower, assist the lodge's chef in preparing your dinner, featuring the fish you caught, before enjoying a delightful meal and spending the night at the eco-lodge.

Day 4**Tan Phong Island Cycling, Crafts & Flight to Da Nang***Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Hoi An | Transport: Bicycle, ferry, car, airplane*

Wake up early to embrace the fresh country air and serene sounds of Tan Phong Island. Take a morning stroll to observe local farmers beginning their day before returning to your eco-lodge for breakfast. Afterward, embark on a cycling tour around the island, offering an intimate glimpse into rural life.

During your cycling excursion, you'll visit various traditional handicraft workshops. Witness the creation of delicate rice papers, a staple in Vietnamese cuisine, at a local home. Learn the intricate art of knitting banana hammocks from banana rope and try your hand at weaving items from water hyacinth. You'll also discover how nail files are crafted using bamboo sticks and natural materials. Conclude your morning with a cooking class back at the Ecolodge, where you'll learn to prepare jackfruit leaf cake, a celebrated local specialty, and savor your own creation.

In the afternoon, check out from the eco-lodge and travel by ferry with locals to Hiep Duc. Awaiting you at the port, a driver will transfer you to the airport for your flight to Da Nang, with a stop for lunch at a restaurant en route back towards Ho Chi Minh City. Upon arrival at Da Nang Airport, you will be driven to your hotel in Hoi An. The remainder of the day is free for relaxation after your travels or to begin exploring the enchanting ancient town of Hoi An as it illuminates at night.
