Day 2**Bangkok Temples & River Journey**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Bangkok | Transport: Car, Long-tail boat

Begin your day with a nourishing breakfast before embarking on a guided exploration of Bangkok's most sacred sites. Your first stop is Wat Traimit, home to the magnificent Golden Buddha, a solid gold statue in a sitting meditation posture, believed to bring good fortune. Continue your cultural journey to Wat Pho, one of Thailand's oldest temples, renowned for its impressive Giant Reclining Buddha and beautiful chedi structures. Next, proceed to the Grand Palace complex, an architectural marvel that historically served as the residence of the Thai King. Within its grounds, you will witness the revered Wat Phra Kaew, also known as the Temple of the Emerald Buddha, housing a precious 14th-century emerald statue. Enjoy an authentic Thai lunch at a local restaurant.

Activities: Visit Wat Traimit; Explore Wat Pho; Tour the Grand Palace and Wat Phra Kaew; Enjoy a canal boat trip; Admire Wat Arun at sunset.

Day 3**Bangkok at Your Own Pace**

Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Bangkok | Transport: NA

This day is designated for independent exploration of Bangkok and its surrounding areas, allowing you the freedom to tailor your experiences to your personal preferences. After enjoying breakfast at your hotel, you have a full day to discover facets of the city that pique your interest. You might choose to revisit a previously enjoyed site, delve deeper into a specific cultural aspect, or perhaps embark on an optional excursion (not included in the tour package). Consider exploring local markets, indulging in a spa treatment, or simply observing daily life from a charming cafe. This flexible day ensures you can fully embrace Bangkok's unique charm at your own pace before continuing your journey.

Activities: Free day for independent exploration.

Day 4**Flight to Chiang Mai & Temple Exploration**

Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Chiang Mai | Transport: Car, Airplane

Enjoy breakfast before an early check-out and transfer to Bangkok airport for a domestic flight to Chiang Mai. Upon arrival in Chiang Mai, a transfer will take you to your hotel for check-in and some rest. In the afternoon, begin exploring Chiang Mai's prominent temples. Your first visit is to Wat Chedi Luang, a Lanna-style Buddhist stupa with a rich history and spiritual

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significance. Continue to Wat Phra Singh, often referred to as the Temple of the Lion Buddha, which showcases an impressive collection of Lanna artwork and architecture. Conclude your temple visits at Wat Suan Dok, where you can admire its serene gardens, ancient chedis, and a 500-year-old bronze Buddha statue. You may even have the opportunity to engage in conversation with resident monks, gaining insights into Thai culture and Buddhist traditions. After a day of cultural immersion, you will be driven back to your hotel to relax.

Activities: Fly to Chiang Mai; Visit Wat Chedi Luang; Explore Wat Phra Singh; Stroll through Wat Suan Dok.

Day 5**Elephant Nature Park Visit**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Chiang Mai | Transport: Car

After breakfast, around 7:30 to 8:00 AM, your guide will meet you in the hotel lobby for a transfer to the Elephant Nature Park. This renowned sanctuary serves as a reservation and rehabilitation center for elephants and various other rescued animals. You will spend your morning learning about the inspiring stories of the rescued and orphaned elephants, and have the opportunity to interact with them in a respectful and ethical environment. Your visit directly contributes to the park's ongoing regional projects, supporting the continuous care for these magnificent creatures and making future rescues possible. A healthy vegan buffet lunch, featuring a diverse selection of Asian and international dishes, will be served at the park. In the afternoon, you will return to your hotel with a comfortable drive, allowing for a well-deserved break.

Activities: Visit Elephant Nature Park; Interact with rescued elephants; Learn about conservation; Enjoy a vegan buffet lunch.

Day 6**Chiang Mai – Flight To Hanoi - Street Food Tour**

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner | Stay: Hotel in Hanoi | Transport: Car, Airplane, Walking

Enjoy your final breakfast in Chiang Mai before checking out from your hotel. A private transfer will then take you to the airport for your flight to Hanoi, Vietnam. Upon your arrival in Vietnam's vibrant capital, a local guide will meet you and provide a comfortable transfer to your hotel, allowing you time to settle in and unwind. In the evening, prepare for an exciting culinary adventure through Hanoi's bustling Old Quarter. Around 17:30, gather with your guide at a designated meeting point to delve into the lively streets, where you'll sample a variety of authentic local street food. This gastronomic journey may include traditional dishes such as Pho Bo (beef noodle soup), Bun Thang, Banh Cuon (steamed rice rolls), or Banh Mi, complemented by a unique Ca Phe Trung (Egg Coffee).

Activities: Fly to Hanoi; Transfer to hotel; Experience a Hanoi street food tour; Sample local dishes like Pho Bo and Egg Coffee.

Day 7**Hanoi Historical & Cultural Exploration**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Hanoi | Transport: Car

Begin the day after breakfast with a guided tour of Hanoi's significant historical landmarks. Your first stop is the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first national university, a beautiful complex dedicated to Confucius and the pursuit of knowledge during the feudal period. Next, visit Ba Dinh Square, a site of immense national importance where President Ho Chi Minh declared

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Vietnam's independence. In the same complex, you will see the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (exterior viewing if closed for renovation) and the unique One Pillar Pagoda, an important Buddhist site. A traditional Vietnamese lunch will be served at a local restaurant, offering a taste of regional cuisine.

Activities: Visit the Temple of Literature; See Ba Dinh Square and Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum; Explore One Pillar Pagoda; Have traditional Vietnamese lunch; Discover the Museum of Ethnology.

Day 8**Ha Long Bay Overnight Cruise**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Stay: Overnight on cruise | Transport: Limousine, Speedboat, Cruise

Following breakfast, a luxury limousine will collect you from your hotel for the approximately 2.5-hour transfer to Ha Long Bay, including a short stop along the way. Upon arrival at the cruise lounge, complete check-in procedures before boarding a speedboat to reach your main cruise vessel. A welcome drink and safety briefing will be provided as you settle into your cabin. Enjoy a diverse lunch while sailing through the breathtaking scenery of Ha Long Bay's iconic limestone islands and emerald waters. The afternoon is dedicated to water-based activities such as exploring a cave, kayaking through serene lagoons, or hiking to an island viewpoint for panoramic vistas.

Activities: Transfer to Ha Long Bay; Board an overnight cruise; Enjoy lunch onboard; Participate in caving or kayaking; Join a cooking class; Enjoy dinner and evening activities.

Day 9**Ha Long Bay Sunrise & Flight to Hoi An**

Meals: Breakfast, Brunch | Stay: Hotel in Hoi An | Transport: Cruise, Speedboat, Car, Airplane

Early risers can start the day with a refreshing Tai Chi session on the deck, followed by a light breakfast. The cruise will then sail towards a local fishing village, offering a glimpse into traditional marine life or a final opportunity to relax by the bay's tranquil waters. Return to the cruise for a comprehensive brunch before completing check-out procedures between 10:00 and 10:30 as the vessel heads back to the pier. A speedboat will transfer you ashore, where you'll meet your driver for a direct transfer to the airport for your flight to Da Nang. Upon arrival in Da Nang, another transfer will take you to your hotel in Hoi An for check-in and an evening of relaxation in this charming and peaceful ancient town after a day of travel.

Activities: Attend a Tai Chi class; Visit a fishing village; Enjoy brunch onboard; Disembark cruise; Fly to Da Nang; Transfer to Hoi An.

Day 10**Hoi An Ancient Town & My Son Sanctuary**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Da Nang | Transport: Walking, Car, Boat

Begin your day with breakfast in Hoi An, followed by check-out from your hotel. Around 8:00 AM, meet your guide to explore the charming alleys and historic architecture of Hoi An Ancient Town, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Your walk will take you to the iconic Japanese Covered Bridge, a symbol of the town's diverse architectural heritage from the 17th century. Next, visit the Fujian Assembly Hall, originally a gathering place for Chinese merchants, which later transformed into Thien Hau Thanh Mau Pagoda. Enjoy some free time to browse for unique, lovingly crafted souvenirs and local handicrafts before savoring a delicious

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cross-cultural lunch.

Activities: Explore Hoi An Ancient Town; Visit Japanese Covered Bridge; See Fujian Assembly Hall; Shop for souvenirs; Visit My Son Sanctuary; Watch a traditional performance; Learn rice paper making; Enjoy a Thu Bon River boat ride.

Day 11**Ba Na Hills & Golden Bridge Adventure**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Da Nang | Transport: Car, Cable car

After breakfast, depart for an exciting full-day excursion to Ba Na Hills. Upon arrival at the base of the hills, you will check in at the Suoi Mo Cable Car Station. Boarding a cable car offers breathtaking panoramic views of the surrounding mountains as you ascend towards Marseille Station. Here, you'll encounter the renowned Golden Bridge, a unique pedestrian walkway held aloft by two colossal stone hands, providing spectacular vistas. Explore the Jardin D'Amour, a beautifully landscaped garden featuring diverse flora, fountains, and sculptures, and visit Linh Ung Pagoda, home to an imposing statue of the Goddess of Mercy. A buffet lunch featuring Vietnamese culinary delights will be served.

Activities: Ride cable car to Ba Na Hills; Walk across the Golden Bridge; Explore Jardin D'Amour; Visit Linh Ung Pagoda; Enjoy buffet lunch; Experience Fantasy Park; See views from King Peak.

Day 12**Da Nang to Ho Chi Minh City Flight & Free Evening**

Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Ho Chi Minh | Transport: Car, Airplane

Enjoy your final breakfast in Da Nang before completing the check-out process from your hotel. Following this, a private transfer will take you to the airport for your domestic flight to Ho Chi Minh City, often still referred to as Saigon. Upon landing at the airport, a local tour guide will be waiting to greet you and facilitate your transfer to your chosen hotel for check-in. The remainder of this day is intentionally left free, providing you with valuable time to recover from your journey or to independently begin uncovering the dynamic energy of this bustling metropolis. For those interested, a variety of optional evening activities are available (at an additional cost), offering opportunities to experience Saigon's vibrant cultural scene or lively nightlife.

Activities: Fly to Ho Chi Minh City; Transfer to hotel; Free time for relaxation or independent exploration.

Day 13**Cu Chi Tunnels & Ho Chi Minh City Landmarks**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Ho Chi Minh | Transport: Minivan

Following breakfast, around 8:00 AM, a minivan will transport you on a two-hour journey through rural landscapes to the historic Cu Chi Tunnels. Here, you'll gain profound insight into their strategic importance during wartime by watching an introductory film. Explore the intricate underground network, including hidden traps, secret entrances, bunkers, and underground hideouts concealed within the jungle. You will have the opportunity to crawl through a section of the tunnels and, if interested, try rifle shooting at an additional cost. Enjoy a light lunch featuring regional cuisine on the return trip to the city center, including specialty cassava with local green tea.

Activities: Visit Cu Chi Tunnels; Watch an introductory film; Explore tunnel network; Try rifle shooting (optional); Visit Reunification

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Old Post Office and Notre Dame Cathedral; Explore War Remnants Museum; Browse Ben Thanh Market.

Day 14**Mekong Delta River Life & Crafts**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Ho Chi Minh | Transport: Car, Boat, Xe Loi/Bicycle, Sampan

After breakfast, around 8:00 AM, depart for Ben Tre province in the heart of the Mekong Delta. Board a boat for a scenic cruise along the Ham Luong River, observing the tranquil riverine lifestyle, including local fishing activities and water transfers. Your journey includes a visit to a local workshop to witness the traditional process of making coconut products, from husk to finished goods. Continue to a mat-weaving house, where you can observe the intricate craft firsthand and sample fresh local fruits and tea. Explore the peaceful village on foot, or opt for a ride on a “xe loi” (motorized rickshaw) or bicycle through lush fruit orchards, showcasing the region's agricultural beauty. A delicious lunch featuring various Mekong Delta dishes will be served.

Activities: Cruise Ham Luong River; Visit coconut processing workshop; See mat-weaving; Taste local fruits and tea; Explore village by xe loi or bicycle; Enjoy Mekong Delta lunch; Take a sampan ride.

Day 15**Ho Chi Minh City to Siem Reap Flight & Leisure**

Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Siem Reap | Transport: Car, Airplane

After enjoying breakfast, complete the check-out formalities at your Ho Chi Minh City hotel. Your dedicated driver will then transport you to the airport for your international flight to Siem Reap, Cambodia. Upon landing at Siem Reap airport, a local guide and driver will be on hand to welcome you and provide a comfortable transfer to your hotel for check-in. The rest of this day is allocated for your personal leisure, allowing you to relax and recharge after your travels or to begin a preliminary exploration of the town. For an adventurous start to your Cambodian experience, an optional sunset-watching excursion by quad bike is available at an additional cost.

Activities: Fly to Siem Reap; Transfer to hotel; Relax or explore independently.

Day 16**Full Day Angkor Temples Exploration**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Siem Reap | Transport: Car

After breakfast, around 8:00 AM, begin a full-day guided tour of the magnificent Angkor temple complex, starting with Angkor Thom, the last great capital city of the Khmer Empire. Within Angkor Thom, explore the Bayon Temple, famous for its numerous smiling faces of Avalokiteshvara, and other significant sites like Phimeanakas, the Royal Enclosure, the Elephants Terrace, and the Terrace of the Leper King. Next, visit the atmospheric Ta Prohm Temple, known for its unique integration with massive fig trees and sprawling vines, creating a truly cinematic setting. Enjoy a delicious lunch of Cambodian specialties at a local restaurant.

Activities: Explore Angkor Thom; Visit Bayon Temple, Phimeanakas, Royal Enclosure, Elephants Terrace, Terrace of the Leper King; See Ta Prohm Temple; Enjoy Cambodian lunch; Discover Angkor Wat; Climb Phnom Bakheng for sunset.

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Day 17**Siem Reap Free Day***Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Siem Reap | Transport: NA*

This entire day is reserved for your independent and flexible exploration of Siem Reap and its captivating surroundings. After breakfast at your hotel, you have the freedom to delve deeper into areas that particularly interest you, beyond the main temple circuit. You might choose to revisit a favorite temple, wander through the vibrant local markets to discover unique crafts and goods, or simply enjoy the amenities and tranquility of your hotel. Additionally, a range of optional excursions are available (at an extra cost), such as a half-day trip to the floating village of Kampong Khleang on Tonle Sap Lake, offering insight into local life, or an exhilarating ziplining adventure for thrill-seekers.

Activities: Free day for independent exploration.
