Day 1

Hanoi Arrival & Welcome Dinner

Meals: D | Stay: Palago Boutique Hotel Hanoi | Transport: Private transfer

Upon your arrival at Hanoi airport, a dedicated transfer service will greet you and transport you directly to your hotel for check-in. The remainder of the day is intentionally left free for you to settle in and relax after your journey, as group members arrive from various international locations.

In the evening, the group will gather for a convivial welcome dinner. This provides an excellent opportunity to meet your fellow travelers, share initial impressions, and begin forging connections before the adventure truly begins.

Day 2

Hanoi Historical Sites & Old Quarter Exploration

Meals: B, L | Stay: Palago Boutique Hotel Hanoi | Transport: Private vehicle, Cyclo

Your day of exploration in Hanoi commences with a visit to the Ho Chi Minh Complex. Here, you'll see Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum, his traditional Stilt-House, the Presidential Palace, and the nearby One Pillar Pagoda, gaining insight into Vietnam's revered leader and architectural heritage. Following this, the journey continues to the Vietnam Museum of Ethnology, where you can delve into the diverse customs and traditions of the nation's 54 ethnic groups.

After a midday lunch, the afternoon features a visit to the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first national university, a serene space dedicated to Confucius. You'll then explore the picturesque Hoan Kiem Lake and the Ngoc Son Temple, often considered the symbolic heart of Hanoi. A unique experience awaits with a one-hour cyclo ride through the charming, narrow streets of the Hanoi Old Quarter, offering a close-up view of daily life.

The day concludes with a traditional Water Puppet Show, an art form deeply rooted in Vietnamese culture, showcasing folklore

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and legends through intricate puppetry. The evening is then yours to enjoy at leisure.

Day 3**Ninh Binh Ancient Capital & Tam Coc Boat Ride**

Meals: B, L | Stay: Hidden Charm Hotel & Resort Ninh Binh | Transport: Private vehicle, bicycle (optional), boat

Today, you'll depart Hanoi by private vehicle for a two-hour drive south to Ninh Binh province. Your first stop is Hoa Lu, the ancient capital of Vietnam from 968 AD to 1010 AD. Here, you'll explore the Dinh Temple and Le Temple, 17th-century structures dedicated to the revered Dinh and Le Kings, offering a glimpse into Vietnam's early dynastic history amidst a scenic backdrop.

Next, you'll have the option to embark on an 18-kilometer bicycle ride to Tam Coc, enjoying the tranquil rural scenery and stopping for photographs along the way. Alternatively, a bus transfer is available if you prefer not to cycle. Upon arrival in Tam Coc, you'll check into your hotel before enjoying lunch at a local restaurant.

The highlight of the afternoon is a two-hour boat trip through Tam Coc, often referred to as the 'Inland Halong Bay'. This serene journey takes you along a river winding through peaceful rice fields, flanked by dramatic limestone formations, and into several grottoes. After returning to the harbor, you'll have free time to visit Hang Mua (Dragon Mountain) independently or stroll through the village to observe local life.

Day 4**Halong Bay Cruise & Cave Exploration**

Meals: B, L, D | Stay: Indochine Grand Cruises | Transport: Private vehicle, cruise ship, tender boat

After breakfast, your journey continues with a transfer to Ha Long Bay, arriving at Tuan Chau Island around midday. You'll proceed to the Pelican Halong Cruise Lounge for a brief rest and welcome drink before transferring to your cruise ship. Once on board, a welcome drink and safety briefing will precede your check-in, marking the start of your exploration of Ha Long Bay, a UNESCO World Heritage site.

A buffet lunch featuring Vietnamese and international dishes will be served as the cruise sails through some of the bay's most beautiful and serene areas, passing iconic islets like Incense Burner, Dog Stone, and Fighting Cock. The afternoon includes a

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visit to the Tung Sau area, known for its cultured pearl fishery, where you can observe the pearl cultivation process. You'll also have the opportunity to go kayaking, if you wish.

Later, the cruise will stop at Ti Top beach, offering a chance for swimming or a climb to the summit for panoramic views of Ha Long Bay. As the boat sails to the Luon Bo area for overnight anchoring, you'll participate in a cooking class on the sundeck, learning to prepare traditional Vietnamese spring rolls. Enjoy a 'Happy Hour' and watch the magnificent sunset before a deluxe Vietnamese and international set dinner. Evening activities include relaxing at the bar, watching movies, playing cards, or trying your hand at squid fishing.

Day 5**Halong Bay Tai Chi & Return to Hanoi**

Meals: B, L | Stay: Palago Boutique Hotel Hanoi | Transport: Cruise ship, tender boat, private vehicle

Begin your day on board with an invigorating Tai Chi session on the sundeck, combining deep breathing with gentle movements as the sun rises over Ha Long Bay. Afterward, a light breakfast of coffee, tea, and pastries will be served in the dining room, offering splendid morning views of the bay's landscape.

Later, a tender boat will transfer you to Sung Sot Cave (Surprise Cave), one of the largest and most impressive caves in Ha Long Bay. You'll ascend approximately 100 steps to the entrance and spend about 45 minutes exploring its magnificent stalactites and stalagmites. Comfortable shoes are highly recommended for this excursion. After your cave visit, you'll return to the cruise ship by tender.

Back on board, you'll check out from your cabin and settle any outstanding bills. A buffet brunch will be served as the cruise makes its way back to Tuan Chau Wharf. Enjoy the scenic views from the sundeck or dining room during the return journey. Upon disembarking at Tuan Chau Wharf, you'll bid farewell to the crew before a private transfer takes you back to your hotel in Hanoi, arriving around 3:00 PM.

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Day 6

Flight to Hue & Rural Lagoon Discovery

Meals: B, L | Stay: Eldora Hotel Hue | Transport: Private transfer, domestic flight, bus, motorized sampan

Following breakfast at your Hanoi hotel, you will be transferred to the airport for a morning flight to Hue. Upon arrival in Hue, your tour guide will meet you and facilitate your transfer to the hotel for check-in. The morning is then free for you to relax or explore at your leisure.

In the afternoon, a bus transfer will take you to Thanh Toan village. Here, you'll visit the ancient, roof-tiled Thanh Toan bridge, a historic 18th-century structure, and have the opportunity to interact with the friendly local community. After a short break to explore the village surroundings, the journey continues to Chuon Lagoon, a historic village with over 600 years of heritage. At Chuon Lagoon, you'll visit the village temple, recognized as a national relic, which showcases the distinctive architectural style of the Nguyen Dynasty. The experience culminates with boarding a small motorized sampan for a cruise around the tranquil waters of the lagoon. During this serene boat trip, you'll have the chance to observe and even practice traditional fishing techniques, gaining insight into the daily lives of local fishermen, before returning to your hotel in the early evening.

Day 7

Your day in Hue begins with a visit to Dong Ba Market, where you can observe the vibrant daily commerce and local life. Following this, you'll embark on a serene Dragon boat trip along the Perfume River, leading you to the Thien Mu Pagoda, the oldest pagoda in Hue and a significant spiritual landmark. The morning concludes with an exploration of the Hue Imperial Citadel, the former home of Vietnam's last royal dynasty, the Nguyen Dynasty, offering a deep dive into imperial history and architecture.

After lunch at a local restaurant, the afternoon is dedicated to visiting the magnificent royal tombs. First, you'll discover Khai Dinh King's Tomb, an architectural marvel that blends Western and Eastern design elements, showcasing intricate details and grandeur. Next, you'll visit Minh Mang King's Tomb, admired for its majestic scale and harmonious symmetry, set within a beautifully landscaped complex.

The day's sightseeing concludes with a leisurely cyclo ride around Hue City, providing a charming perspective of the urban landscape before you are transferred back to your hotel in the late afternoon.

Day 8**Scenic Drive to Hoi An & Ancient Town Walk**

Today, you'll embark on a scenic car transfer from Hue to Hoi An Ancient Town. The journey itself is a highlight, offering breathtaking views as you pass along Lang Co Beach, traverse the dramatic Hai Van Pass, and briefly glimpse Da Nang City. Upon arrival in Hoi An around midday, you'll check into your hotel and enjoy a satisfying lunch.

In the afternoon, your Hoi An city tour begins with a visit to the UNESCO-listed Ancient Town. You'll explore its charming streets and historical sites, including the iconic Japanese Covered Bridge, a symbol of Hoi An's multicultural past. After immersing yourself in the town's unique atmosphere, the tour continues with a drive to Tra Que Vegetable Village.

At Tra Que, you'll have the opportunity to observe local farmers cultivating their produce using traditional methods, and even try your hand at some farming activities. Following this experience, you can choose to return to your hotel or spend more time wandering through the ancient town, enjoying its enchanting ambiance as night falls and the lanterns illuminate the streets.

Day 9**My Son Sanctuary & Coconut Forest Basket Boat**

Meals: B, L | Stay: Lasenta Boutique Hotel Hoi An | Transport: Private vehicle, basket boat

Your day begins with a morning drive southwest of Hoi An to My Son Sanctuary, a UNESCO World Heritage site located approximately 40 kilometers away. Set within a lush valley, My Son was once a significant capital and religious center for the Cham people. Here, you'll explore the impressive remains of red brick towers and sanctuaries, which date from the 7th to the 13th centuries, offering a profound insight into the ancient Cham civilization. My Son is recognized as one of Southeast Asia's most important archaeological sites.

After your exploration of My Son, you'll return to Hoi An for lunch. The afternoon features a visit to Cam Thanh village. Upon arrival, you'll visit a local family known for their traditional fish sauce production, learning about this age-old craft. You'll also admire the unique architecture of countryside houses, often constructed from coconut characteristics, and witness artisans creating furniture from water coconut and bamboo.

The journey continues to a fishing village, where you'll explore the Bay Mau Water Coconut Forest. A highlight of this visit is an unforgettable experience on a unique basket boat, navigating through the waterways of the coconut forest. This immersive activity provides a glimpse into the local way of life and the natural beauty of the area. Afterward, you'll return to your hotel, with the evening free for leisure.

Day 10**Flight to Ho Chi Minh City & City Landmarks**

Meals: B, L | Stay: Silverland Ben Thanh Hotel | Transport: Private transfer, domestic flight, private vehicle

In the morning, you will be transferred to the airport for a flight to Ho Chi Minh City. Upon arrival, a private vehicle will take you to the city center to begin your city tour. Your first stop is the Reunification Palace, the former residence of the President of South Vietnam before April 30, 1975. Nearby, you'll visit the iconic Notre Dame Cathedral and the historic Saigon Central Post Office, both showcasing French colonial architecture. A stop at a lacquerware workshop will provide insight into this traditional Vietnamese craft.

After lunch at a local restaurant, the tour continues with a visit to the War Remnants Museum. This museum offers a poignant display of both the Indochina wars, featuring massive military vehicles in the courtyard and recreations of 'tiger cages' to convey the experience of wartime prisoners. Inside, each floor presents a different theme related to the war and its impact on the Vietnamese people.

Next, you'll visit the Museum of Vietnam History to delve deeper into the rich historical narrative of the country. The tour concludes at Ben Thanh Market, a bustling hub where you can find a wide array of goods and sample various local foods. You have the option to return to your hotel with the tour guide or enjoy free time to explore the market and surrounding area independently before making your own way back.

Day 11**Cao Dai Temple & Cu Chi Tunnels Exploration**

Meals: B, L | Stay: Silverland Ben Thanh Hotel | Transport: Private vehicle

Your day begins with a morning pick-up from your hotel for a transfer to Tay Ninh province, located about 100 kilometers southeast of Ho Chi Minh City, near the Cambodian border. Here, you'll visit the unique Cao Dai Temple, the spiritual center of the Cao Dai sect. The temple is renowned for its vibrant, multi-colored decorations, featuring dragons and swastikas, and the all-seeing holy eye symbol above the main entrance. The interior is equally striking, with statues of Jesus Christ, Buddha, and the Hindu god Brahma standing side by side, reflecting the religion's eclectic mix of faiths.

Upon arrival around 10:00 AM, you'll have time to walk around the temple grounds, admire its distinctive architecture, and learn

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about the Cao Dai religion. At 11:45 AM, the temple opens for the midday ceremony, allowing you to find a good vantage point to observe the ritual. You'll participate in the captivating ceremony, gaining a deeper understanding of this fascinating spiritual practice.

Following the ceremony, you'll transfer to Cu Chi for lunch at a local restaurant. In the afternoon, you'll begin exploring the Cu Chi Tunnel Complex, a remarkable network where guerrilla warfare was perfected. You'll learn about the clever design of the tunnels, including strategic trap doors, and how thousands of guerrillas managed to live underground for extended periods, even concealing smoke from their cooking. You'll have the chance to crawl through a portion of the extensive 121-kilometer multi-layered tunnel system, experiencing a small part of this incredible historical site. The tour concludes with a drive back to Ho Chi Minh City, arriving at your hotel around 6:00 PM.

Today, your journey takes you to the serene water world of the Mekong Delta. After being picked up from your hotel in Ho Chi Minh City, you'll embark on an excursion to My Tho, one of the quieter cities in the region. The drive offers picturesque views of fertile paddy fields and water buffalo, setting the scene for your delta adventure.

Upon reaching My Tho, you'll take a boat trip along narrow waterways, providing an intimate look at local life. The trip includes visits to lush orchards and local houses where traditional rice paper is made. You'll have the opportunity to taste tropical fruits and enjoy a performance of southern traditional 'Tai Tu music,' a unique cultural experience. Lunch will be a special affair, featuring the local delicacy 'Elephant's Ear Fish,' served at a restaurant on one of the islands.

After the boat trip, you'll transfer by private vehicle to Can Tho. En route, a stop will be made to visit the ancient Vinh Trang Pagoda, known for its beautiful architecture. You'll arrive in Can Tho around 5:00 PM, check into your hotel, and have free time before enjoying dinner at a charming restaurant situated along a branch of the Hau River. The rest of the evening is at your leisure.

After breakfast at your hotel, you'll transfer to the pier for a boat ride on the Mekong River, one of Asia's most significant waterways. The highlight of the morning is a visit to the famous Cai Rang floating market, where you can witness the bustling daily lives of local people selling their produce directly from boats. This vibrant market offers a unique glimpse into the delta's commercial heart.

Following the floating market, the boat will cruise through smaller canals, taking you to visit a local family and their orchard. Here, you'll have the chance to taste fresh tropical fruits and enjoy a cup of green tea, experiencing the hospitality of the Mekong Delta. This provides a personal connection with the local culture and agricultural practices.

You'll then return to Can Tho City for lunch before boarding a private vehicle for your return journey to Ho Chi Minh City. The drive will bring you back to your hotel in Ho Chi Minh City around 5:00 PM, concluding your exploration of the Mekong Delta.
