Day 2

Bat Trang Pottery Village & Hanoi Old Quarter Cyclo Ride

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Your morning begins with a 9:00 AM departure from Hanoi's city center, heading approximately 10 kilometers to the renowned Bat Trang Pottery Village. This historic village, nestled amidst fertile farmlands, is famous for its long-standing tradition of ceramic production. You'll have the opportunity to wander through its narrow, winding alleys, observing skilled artisans at work in their workshops and browsing showrooms displaying their exquisite pottery.

Engage in a hands-on experience by crafting your own ceramic piece, creating a personal souvenir of your visit. After a brief pause, the journey continues back to Hanoi for a charming cyclo tour. This traditional three-wheeled bicycle taxi will transport you through the captivating Old Quarter, an area characterized by its 36 ancient streets. The architecture, reminiscent of old-school French colonial styles, provides a vivid window into Hanoi's past. The evening concludes with another overnight stay in Hanoi.

Following breakfast at your Hanoi hotel, you will depart at 9:00 AM for a scenic 2.5-hour drive to Ha Long Bay. Upon arrival at Indochine Lounge (Indochina Sails) at Tuan Chau International Port (No. 22), Ha Long City, you will complete check-in and registration between 11:30 AM and 11:45 AM. Shortly after, you will embark on the Indochine Premium Cruise, where a refreshing welcome drink awaits, accompanied by an essential safety briefing.

A delicious buffet lunch will be served in the ship's restaurant from 1:15 PM to 2:00 PM, offering panoramic views as the cruise navigates through Ha Long Bay's breathtaking islands. The afternoon features a scenic journey past iconic geological formations like Incense Burner and Kissing Rock. At 2:30 PM, prepare for an adventure to Luon Cave, where you can choose between a relaxing sampan boat ride, expertly rowed by locals, or paddling a two-person kayak through its tranquil waters. Later, from 4:00 PM, you will take a guided walk through Surprise Cave (Sung Sot Cave), one of the largest and most impressive grottoes in Ha Long Bay, with approximately 45 minutes allocated for exploration.

At 6:30 AM, you have the option to revitalize with a 30-minute Tai Chi session on the sundeck or in the Sky Lounge, weather permitting. From 7:45 AM to 9:00 AM, explore Titov Island. Here, you can choose to enjoy a refreshing swim in the bay's waters or embark on a climb to the island's peak, which offers breathtaking panoramic views of Ha Long Bay. Return to the boat by 9:00 AM to freshen up and finalize your packing. Please leave any heavy luggage outside your cabin for transfer. Between 9:30 AM and 11:00 AM, settle your bill at the reception on Deck 1 and then enjoy a scenic brunch as the cruise approaches the pier. Disembark at Tuan Chau Port around 11:00 AM and relax at the pier while awaiting your return transport to Hanoi. You are expected to arrive in Hanoi around 3:00 PM, where you will have some free time before heading to the train station to board the night train to Lao Cai, scheduled for a 9:00 PM departure.

This serves as a significant meeting point for numerous small ethnic groups, including the Flower H'mong, Nung, and Giay, who come to trade goods such as tobacco, fruits, clothing, and livestock like horses and buffaloes.

During your journey to the market, you will be treated to breathtaking mountain scenery, charming rivers, and expansive terraced rice fields that stretch along the Chinese border. After exploring the market and experiencing its unique atmosphere, you will be transferred back to Lao Cai. From there, you will board a comfortable Limousine tourist bus for your return journey to Hanoi. You are expected to arrive in Hanoi around 7:30 PM, where you will check into your hotel for the night.

Your itinerary includes visits to several significant landmarks, starting with the former Presidential Palace, also known as the Reunification Palace, a symbol of Vietnam's past. Next, you will explore the War Remnants Museum, which offers a poignant look at the country's wartime history. The tour continues to the iconic Notre Dame Cathedral and the historic Saigon Central Post Office, both showcasing French colonial architecture. You'll also experience the lively atmosphere of Ben Thanh Market and make a stop at a local lacquerware workshop to observe traditional craftsmanship.

Following lunch at 12:00 PM, you will embark on a drive of approximately 1.5 hours (65 km) from Saigon to the extraordinary Cu Chi Tunnels. This intricate underground network was constructed by Viet Cong guerrillas during the Vietnam War, serving as living quarters, supply routes, and hiding spots. En route, you'll pass through rural landscapes, observing local people engaged in various occupations such as cashew nut farming, duck breeding, rice cultivation, and the production of rice paper, a staple in Vietnamese cuisine. You will have the opportunity to explore parts of the tunnel system and learn about the ingenuity

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and resilience of those who lived there. The tour concludes with your return to Saigon around 5:00 PM, allowing for an evening at leisure.

As lunch is served, the boat will begin its gentle cruise, allowing you to relax and observe the captivating scenery and daily life along the Mekong River. In the afternoon, you will have the opportunity to disembark for a guided, leisurely stroll through a local village. This walk will take you through lush fruit orchards and verdant rice fields, offering a close-up view of rural life. You'll meet friendly locals, gaining insight into their culture, and taste some of the fresh, local produce and fruits. After returning to the cruise boat, you can enjoy a drink at the bar or relax on deck as the sun sets over the magnificent water landscape. Wake up to the gentle sounds of the river, refreshed and ready for another exciting day exploring the Mekong Delta. At 6:30 AM, the cruise vessel will set off for a sunrise cruise. During this early morning journey, you can observe locals going about

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their daily work, such as drying exotic fruits and constructing ships in wooden yards, all while enjoying an early breakfast on board.

After breakfast, you will transfer to a sampan boat to visit the Cai Rang floating market, known as one of the region's busiest and most lively markets. On even dates, an alternative exploration involves navigating the smaller channels around Cai Be by sampan or on foot. You'll marvel at the sheer abundance of exotic fruits and vegetables, pulling up alongside merchant boats for conversation and bargaining. The itinerary also includes visits to local candy and cake-making factories, or a boat trip through the lush green waterways to see traditional houses, verdant orchards, and shipbuilding yards.

Later in the morning, you can take a small rowing sampan deeper into the green water landscape to observe local homes, vibrant orchards, and boat-building activities. Alternatively, explore the nearby town on foot or cycle along the small side canals of the Mekong River. The cruise boat then resumes its journey, with lunch served onboard. In the afternoon, another side trip will take you to one of the charming exotic villages situated along the riverbanks, offering further cultural insights before returning to the main vessel for the night.

Depending on the specific location, you will either visit the Cai Rang floating market in Can Tho or explore the delta around Cai Be by foot or with a small sampan. This morning provides excellent opportunities for capturing authentic snapshots of the Mekong people and their daily lives, offering a final chance to observe the unique riverine culture.

Take another sampan side trip, venturing right into the lush rural landscape, characterized by fertile fields and exuberant green vegetation.
