DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Day 1

Cycling to Cam Kim Island's Traditional Craft Villages

Meals: Lunch | Transport: Bicycles

Your day begins at 8:00 AM with a meeting at your hotel. A local guide will greet you, assist with bike checks, and provide a helmet before you set off. The cycling journey covers approximately 10 kilometers, leading you to the serene Cam Kim Island. The path is mostly small, paved country roads, offering a pleasant ride through expansive paddy and corn fields, past charming local hamlets that showcase rural Vietnamese life.

Upon reaching Dong Binh Mat village, a significant portion of the community still practices the age-old craft of mat weaving. You'll have the opportunity to dismount and take a leisurely walk around the village, observing firsthand how local artisans meticulously create traditional mats. After gaining insight into this unique handicraft, you'll bid farewell to Dong Binh and continue your cycling adventure.

The route then leads to Tra Nhieu village, renowned for its beautiful water coconut forests. Here, you'll be welcomed into a local family's home to enjoy a delicious, authentic lunch. Following your meal, a fun and interactive experience awaits: you'll join a fisherman and learn the traditional technique of casting a fishing net to catch fish, shrimp, and crab. This hands-on activity provides a deeper connection to the local way of life.

Continuing your exploration, you'll cycle another 3 kilometers to the northern side of the island, arriving at Kim Bong carpentry village. This village boasts a rich history of traditional woodworking, with skilled craftsmen having built boats, elaborate wooden houses, and furniture for Hoi An's Old Town since the 18th century. You'll take a brief stop to visit a family engaged in making traditional noodles and rice paper, observing their craft. By 5:00 PM, you'll cycle back to your hotel, or you can opt for a drop-off in Hoi An's Old Town to enjoy dinner and an evening walk at your leisure.

- Activities:** Meet your guide and prepare bicycles at your hotel.
Cycle approximately 10 kilometers to Cam Kim Island.
Explore Dong Binh Mat village and observe traditional mat weaving.
Continue cycling to Tra Nhieu village, known for its water coconut forests.
Enjoy a traditional lunch with a local family in Tra Nhieu.
Engage in a hands-on fishing experience with a local fisherman.
Cycle an additional 3 kilometers to Kim Bong carpentry village.
Visit a local family producing noodles and rice paper.
Return cycling to Hoi An or be dropped off in the Old Town.
