DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Day 1

Cycling through Hue's History and Thuy Bieu Village Culture

Transport: Mountain bike, dragon's boat, bicycle

Your day begins at 8:00 AM with a convenient pickup from your hotel in Hue. You'll be provided with a mountain bike and helmet to commence your cycling adventure. The first stop is the historic Tiger Fighting Arena (Ho Quyen), a significant relic where elephants and tigers once engaged in combat for the entertainment of emperors and the royal family. This site offers a unique glimpse into the pastimes of Vietnam's imperial court.

Continuing your ride, you'll pedal towards the Elephant Temple, a royal sanctuary dedicated to honoring and burying the King's war elephants. This temple reflects the deep respect and importance accorded to these animals in Vietnamese history. The cycling route then leads you into the serene Thuy Bieu village, known for its tranquil atmosphere and lush pomelo gardens. Within Thuy Bieu, your journey takes you to a local house where you can observe the intricate craft of silk painting by skilled villagers. Following this, you'll visit another private residence to learn about the traditional art of making incense sticks, an essential item for Buddhist worship and ancestor anniversaries in Hue. A highlight of the cultural immersion is participating in the creation of "banh nam" and "banh loc," two distinctive Hue specialty cakes, guided by a local host. You'll have the pleasure of tasting these freshly made delicacies.

After exploring the village and its crafts, you'll continue cycling along the peaceful village roads before transitioning to a dragon's boat. This relaxing boat trip along the Perfume River offers picturesque views as you cruise back towards the city center. The boat will dock at Toa Kham Boat Dock, from where you'll cycle back to your hotel, concluding a day rich in history, culture, and local interaction.
