The route also includes segments of the historic Ho Chi Minh Trail, the vital supply line that snaked through the jungle, and passes through Dong Ha Town, a significant logistical hub, along with views of the formidable Rock Pile.

Cultural Encounter with the Van Kieu People

Beyond the historical landscapes, this tour offers a chance to connect with the living culture of Central Vietnam. A visit to a village inhabited by the Van Kieu ethnic minority provides a valuable opportunity to learn about their traditional way of life, customs, and daily routines. Walking through these tunnels offers a tangible sense of the resilience and resourcefulness of the Vietnamese people who endured unimaginable hardships.

The tour then proceeds to the western part of the DMZ, visiting the historic Khe Sanh Combat Base. This site was the scene of a prolonged and brutal siege, a pivotal moment in the conflict. You will gain insights into the strategic importance of the base and the fierce battles fought there. The route also includes driving along sections of the legendary Ho Chi Minh Trail, observing Dong Ha Town, a key logistical hub, and viewing the formidable Rock Pile, a former observation post.

Before returning to Hue, the tour includes a visit to a village inhabited by the Van Kieu ethnic minority. This cultural stop provides an opportunity to interact with local people and learn about their traditional customs, daily life, and unique heritage, offering a different perspective on the region beyond its wartime history. You will be transferred back to your hotel in Hue in the late afternoon.
