Day 1

Hue City Exploration by Cyclo & Imperial Citadel Visit

Transport: Cyclo, taxi

Your half-day adventure begins at 8:00 AM with a convenient hotel pickup. A taxi will transfer you to the designated cyclo parking area, where you'll meet your driver and begin your unique journey. The initial part of the tour focuses on the modern southern bank of the Perfume River, offering views of contemporary Hue as you travel along streets such as Hoang Hoa Tham, Ly Thuong Kiet, Nguyen Hue, Ba Trieu, Nguyen Cong Tru, and Le Loi. This segment provides a contrast between the city's newer developments and its ancient heart.

Around 9:00 AM, the cyclo will cross the historic Trang Tien Bridge, transitioning into the old city. Here, the primary destination is the magnificent Hue Imperial Citadel, a UNESCO World Heritage site. You'll spend approximately two hours exploring this vast complex, which served as the seat of Vietnam's last imperial dynasty from 1802 to 1945. Highlights include the towering Flag Tower, the Nine Holy Cannons, the grand Ngo Gate, the opulent Thai Hoa Palace, the symbolic Nine Dynastic Urns, and the remains of the Forbidden Purple City.

After immersing yourself in imperial history, the cyclo tour continues around 11:00 AM, allowing you to discover the remaining charm of old Hue. Your cyclo will navigate through picturesque streets like Doan Thi Diem, Tinh Tam, Dinh Tien Hoang, Le Van Huu, Phung Hung, Thach Han, Nguyen Trai, and Le Duan. This part of the journey offers a glimpse into the daily rhythm of local life within the historic district, showcasing traditional architecture and community interactions. The tour gracefully concludes around 12:00 PM, with your cyclo returning you directly to your hotel.
