DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Day 1

Luang Prabang Arrival & Leisure

Meals: NA | Stay: Hotel in Luang Prabang

Upon landing at Luang Prabang Airport, a local driver will meet you for a private transfer to your hotel. After checking in, the remainder of your day is free to unwind or begin exploring the charming surroundings at your own pace. This initial period allows for relaxation and adjustment to the local time zone before the tour's activities commence.

Activities: Arrive in Luang Prabang; Transfer to hotel; Settle in and relax.

Day 2

Luang Prabang Monastic Rituals & Mekong River Cruise

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Luang Prabang

Begin your day at dawn by observing the revered Buddhist almsgiving ceremony, a deeply spiritual tradition where monks collect offerings from local residents. Afterward, visit a bustling local morning market to experience the vibrant street food culture of Laos. Return to your hotel for breakfast before continuing your exploration.

Later, embark on a scenic cruise along the Mekong River to the Pak Ou Caves, a sacred site filled with thousands of Buddha statues spanning centuries. On your return, stop at Ban Muang Keo, a village renowned for its traditional rice whisky.

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production. Conclude the day with a visit to the Traditional Arts and Ethnology Centre, offering insights into Laos' diverse ethnic groups and rich cultural heritage.

Activities: Witness Buddhist almsgiving ceremony; Explore local morning market; Cruise Mekong River; Visit Pak Ou Caves; Stop at Ban Muang Keo village; Visit Traditional Arts and Ethnology Centre.

Day 3**Kuang Si Waterfalls & Journey to Vientiane**

Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Vientiane

After breakfast, depart to discover Luang Prabang's natural splendor. Journey to the Kuang Si Waterfalls, famous for their stunning turquoise pools cascading through lush tropical forests. Close by, visit the Tat Kuang Si Bear Rescue Centre, a sanctuary dedicated to protecting rescued bears and supporting wildlife conservation.

Your next stop is the Ock Pop Tok Living Craft Center, where you can observe traditional Lao weaving and textile craftsmanship firsthand. Following the tour, transfer to the train station for your scenic ride to Vientiane. Upon arrival, a driver will meet you and transfer you to your hotel for check-in, leaving the rest of the day free for personal leisure.

Activities: Visit Kuang Si Waterfalls; Explore Tat Kuang Si Bear Rescue Centre; Observe traditional weaving at Ock Pop Tok Living Craft Center; Transfer to Vientiane by train; Check into hotel.

Day 4**Vientiane Temples & Mekong Sunset**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Vientiane

Following breakfast, embark on a comprehensive tour of Vientiane's significant cultural and spiritual sites. Your first stop is Wat Si Muang, a revered Khmer-style temple believed to bestow good fortune and protection, popular for daily local prayers.

Continue to Buddha Park (Xieng Khuan), an open-air sculpture garden showcasing hundreds of Buddhist and Hindu statues along the tranquil Mekong River.

Enjoy a break for lunch before resuming your afternoon itinerary. Visit Wat Sisaket and Wat Prakeo, both ancient temples now serving as museums displaying countless historic Buddha images. Proceed to Pha That Luang, Laos' most important national monument, symbolizing Buddhist faith and national sovereignty. Conclude your tour at the iconic Patuxai Monument, where you can learn about Laos' historical influences and enjoy panoramic city views. The day ends with a relaxing sunset view over the Mekong River.

Activities: Visit Wat Si Muang; Explore Buddha Park (Xieng Khuan); Visit Wat Sisaket and Wat Prakeo; See Pha That Luang; Climb Patuxai Monument; Enjoy sunset over Mekong River.

Day 5**Vientiane Departure & Hanoi Arrival**

Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Hanoi

Enjoy a relaxed morning in Vientiane, allowing for some personal time before your scheduled transfer to the airport. Board your flight to Hanoi, Vietnam's vibrant capital. Upon arrival at Noi Bai International Airport, a driver will meet you and provide a

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comfortable transfer to your hotel for check-in. Standard check-in time is typically from 2:00 PM; please note that early check-in may incur an additional charge.

The rest of the day is at your leisure, offering an opportunity to relax or independently explore the initial surroundings of Hanoi. For those interested in culinary adventures, optional evening street food tours by foot or motorbike are available to discover Hanoi's rich gastronomic scene.

Activities: Free time in Vientiane; Transfer to Vientiane Airport; Fly to Hanoi; Transfer to Hanoi hotel; Relax or explore independently.

Day 6**Halong Bay Overnight Cruise Exploration**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Stay: Halong Bay Cruise

After breakfast at your Hanoi hotel, you will be picked up by your driver between 8:00 AM and 8:30 AM for a transfer to the Halong Bay cruise port. Upon arrival, complete the necessary check-in procedures and board your chosen cruise ship. You will be greeted with a refreshing welcome drink and a brief orientation from the crew.

A freshly prepared lunch will be served as your vessel navigates through the breathtaking limestone seascape of Halong Bay, a designated UNESCO World Heritage Site. The afternoon is dedicated to exploring the bay's iconic attractions, which may include the impressive Sung Sot Cave, the serene Dark & Light Cave, or the cultural Viet Hai Village, depending on your cruise's specific itinerary. Return to the ship for onboard activities such as a cooking demonstration or happy hour. A delicious dinner will be served as you spend the night surrounded by the peaceful ambiance of the bay.

Activities: Transfer to Halong Bay; Board cruise ship; Enjoy lunch while cruising; Explore Halong Bay highlights (e.g., Sung Sot Cave, Dark & Light Cave, Viet Hai Village); Participate in cooking demonstration; Enjoy dinner; Overnight on cruise.

Day 7**Halong Bay Sunrise & Return to Hanoi**

Meals: Breakfast, Brunch | Stay: Hotel in Hanoi

Begin your day with a tranquil Tai Chi session on the sundeck, taking in the serene morning views of Halong Bay as the sun rises. A light breakfast will be served on board. Continue your cruise experience with a final visit to another of the bay's notable sites, such as a hidden cave or a local fishing village, depending on the day's itinerary.

After these explorations, return to the ship to check out from your cabin. A delightful brunch will be served as your cruise sails back towards the harbor. Upon disembarkation at the port, your driver will be waiting to transfer you directly back to your hotel in Hanoi. The rest of the afternoon and evening are free for you to relax or explore Hanoi at your leisure.

Activities: Tai Chi session; Light breakfast; Visit Halong Bay site (cave/fishing village); Brunch on board; Disembark cruise; Transfer back to Hanoi; Check into hotel; Free time in Hanoi.

Day 8**Hanoi to Hoi An & Ancient Town Discovery**

Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Hoi An

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel in Hanoi before transferring to the airport for your flight to Da Nang. Upon arrival, a local

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representative will meet you and provide a comfortable transfer to your hotel in the charming town of Hoi An. After checking in and settling into your accommodation, the remainder of your day is free.

You can spend this time strolling through the historic old town, a UNESCO World Heritage site, to observe local life, admire the unique architecture, and soak in the cultural atmosphere. Optional activities are available for those wishing to delve deeper, such as a basket boat tour in Cam Thanh Coconut Village, an evening food tour by bike, or attending the Teh Dar Show at Hoi An Lune Center.

Activities: Breakfast in Hanoi; Transfer to Hanoi Airport; Fly to Da Nang; Transfer to Hoi An hotel; Check in; Explore Hoi An Old Town independently.

Day 9**Hoi An Cultural Walking Tour**

Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Hoi An

Your morning begins with an immersive walking tour of Hoi An, starting at the bustling Hoi An Market. Here, you'll find vibrant stalls offering fresh produce, local snacks, and everyday items, providing a glimpse into the town's daily rhythm. Continue to the Phuc Kien Chinese Assembly Hall, admired for its intricate architecture and active family altar. Explore the Phung Hung Ancient House and Tan Ky Ancient House, two remarkably preserved merchant homes that highlight Hoi An's rich trading history.

Next, visit the Museum of Folk Culture, housed in a 150-year-old building, showcasing traditional crafts and daily life. Enjoy a short cultural performance at the Hoi An Traditional Performing Arts House. The tour proceeds to the iconic Japanese Covered Bridge, a 400-year-old landmark connecting the former Japanese and Chinese quarters. Conclude your exploration with time to browse local handicraft shops, art galleries, and peaceful laneways, absorbing the relaxed charm of Hoi An.

Activities: Explore Hoi An Market; Visit Phuc Kien Chinese Assembly Hall; Tour Phung Hung Ancient House and Tan Ky Ancient House; Discover Museum of Folk Culture; Attend cultural performance; See Japanese Covered Bridge; Browse local shops.

Day 10**Hoi An Leisure & Flight to Ho Chi Minh City**

Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Ho Chi Minh City

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast at your hotel, followed by a free morning to soak in the tranquil ambiance of Hoi An's ancient town. This is a perfect opportunity for some last-minute souvenir shopping or simply relaxing before your onward journey. Later, you will be transferred to Da Nang airport for your flight to Ho Chi Minh City, formerly known as Saigon.

Upon arrival at the airport, a private transfer will take you to your hotel for check-in. The rest of the day is yours to relax and settle in. As the 'city that never sleeps,' Ho Chi Minh City offers a vibrant nightlife. Consider an optional evening experience like a Saigon Night Life Tour by Motorbike, a Dinner Cruise on the Saigon River, or attending the cultural A O Show Saigon.

Activities: Free morning in Hoi An; Transfer to Da Nang Airport; Fly to Ho Chi Minh City; Transfer to Ho Chi Minh City hotel; Check in; Relax or explore evening options.

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Day 11**Cu Chi Tunnels & Ho Chi Minh City Landmarks***Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Ho Chi Minh City*

After breakfast, depart from your hotel for an excursion to the Cu Chi Tunnels, an extensive underground network used by Viet Cong soldiers during the Vietnam War. Explore the hidden tunnel systems, gaining insight into the challenging wartime survival conditions and Vietnam's military history. An optional shooting range experience is available for an additional charge.

Return to Ho Chi Minh City for a light lunch before continuing your afternoon sightseeing. Your city tour includes passing by the Saigon Opera House, an elegant example of French colonial architecture. Visit the Saigon City Hall, also inspired by French Renaissance Revival design, which now hosts official conferences. Stop by the Notre Dame Cathedral (currently under renovation) and the Old Post Office on Cong Xa Paris Street, both considered timeless architectural symbols of the city.

Conclude your day with a stop at Ben Thanh Market, an ideal spot for souvenir shopping.

Activities: Travel to Cu Chi Tunnels; Explore underground tunnels; Return to Ho Chi Minh City; Pass by Saigon Opera House; Visit Saigon City Hall; See Notre Dame Cathedral and Old Post Office; Shop at Ben Thanh Market.

Day 12**Ho Chi Minh City Departure & Siem Reap Arrival***Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Siem Reap*

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel and take advantage of a free morning to relax or conduct any last-minute activities before the standard check-out time of 12:00 noon. Later, a private transfer will take you to Tan Son Nhat International Airport for your flight to Siem Reap, Cambodia.

Upon arrival at Siem Reap International Airport, you will be met by a local representative and transferred to your hotel for check-in. The rest of the day is free for you to unwind after your journey or begin a gentle exploration of Siem Reap at your own leisure. Please note that late check-out from your Ho Chi Minh City hotel is not included in the tour package.

Activities: Free morning in Ho Chi Minh City; Transfer to Tan Son Nhat International Airport; Fly to Siem Reap; Transfer to Siem Reap hotel; Check in; Relax or explore independently.

Day 13**Ta Prohm & Angkor Wat Exploration***Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Siem Reap*

Begin your day with a visit to Ta Prohm Temple, originally established as a Buddhist monastery and school during the reign of Jayavarman VII. Today, this temple is famously intertwined with the surrounding jungle, where massive tree roots dramatically embrace its stone structures, creating an atmospheric and photogenic setting.

In the afternoon, discover the world-renowned Angkor Wat, the largest religious monument globally and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Spend ample time exploring its intricate carvings, grand courtyards, and iconic towers. As the late afternoon approaches, seize the opportunity to witness a spectacular sunset over Angkor Wat or from another designated scenic viewpoint within the vast temple complex, offering a memorable end to your day of exploration.

Activities: Visit Ta Prohm Temple; Explore Angkor Wat; Witness sunset over Angkor Wat.

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Day 14**Siem Reap Leisure & Optional Adventures***Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Siem Reap*

Today offers a full day at your leisure to uncover more of Siem Reap's hidden charms at your own pace. You might choose to simply relax at your hotel, enjoy the local cafes, or explore the town's markets and artisan workshops. For those seeking additional cultural or adventure experiences, several optional excursions are available.

You could opt for a half-day Siem Reap Zipline adventure for an exhilarating perspective of the Cambodian jungle, or a full-day trip to Kbal Spean, known as "The River of a Thousand Lingas," featuring ancient carvings in a natural riverbed. Another option is a half-day visit to Chong Kneas Floating Village, offering insight into life on Tonle Sap Lake.

Activities: Full day at leisure in Siem Reap; Optional activities: Siem Reap Zipline, Kbal Spean, Chong Kneas Floating Village.

Day 15**Siem Reap Departure & Bangkok Arrival***Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Bangkok*

After breakfast at your hotel, you will be transferred to Siem Reap International Airport for your flight to Bangkok, Thailand. Upon arrival at Bangkok Airport, a local representative will meet you and provide a comfortable transfer to your city hotel for check-in. The remainder of the day is free for you to relax and recover from your journey, or to begin a gentle exploration of Bangkok's immediate surroundings.

For travelers eager to engage in more activities, optional experiences such as a Sunset by Quad Excursion or a half-day tour of Angkor Thom are available for those who might have extended their stay in Siem Reap.

Activities: Transfer to Siem Reap Airport; Fly to Bangkok; Transfer to Bangkok hotel; Check in; Relax or explore independently.

Day 16**Bangkok Temples & Canal Life***Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Bangkok*

Following breakfast at your hotel, embark on a full-day exploration of Bangkok's most iconic cultural landmarks. Your journey begins with a visit to Wat Pho, home to the revered Reclining Buddha, and Wat Traimit, famous for its impressive Golden Buddha statue. Both temples provide a deeper understanding of Thai Buddhist traditions and heritage.

Continue to the magnificent Grand Palace, the former royal residence of the Kings of Siam, still utilized for significant royal ceremonies and state events. Enjoy a relaxing boat trip along Bangkok's intricate network of canals, offering a unique perspective of local neighborhoods and traditional riverside life. Make a stop at Khlong Bang Luang Artist Village, where you can appreciate local art and creative community spaces. Conclude your day at Wat Arun, the Temple of Dawn, one of Bangkok's most recognizable landmarks, noted for its riverside location and striking 79-meter central spire.

Activities: Visit Wat Pho (Reclining Buddha); See Wat Traimit (Golden Buddha); Explore Grand Palace; Take a boat tour along Bangkok canals; Stop at Khlong Bang Luang Artist Village; Visit Wat Arun (Temple of Dawn).

Day 17**Ayutthaya Historical Park Excursion**

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Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Bangkok

After breakfast, depart for a full-day excursion to Ayutthaya, the former capital of the Siamese Kingdom and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Your first stop is Bang Pa-In Royal Palace, also known as the Summer Palace, a beautifully preserved complex showcasing elegant Thai, Chinese, and European architectural styles amidst landscaped gardens and lakes. Continue to Wat Yai Chai Mongkol, one of Ayutthaya's most significant temples, distinguished by its large pagoda and serene atmosphere. Explore Wat Phra Sri Sanphet, once part of the royal palace, followed by Wat Mahathat, famous for the iconic Buddha head entwined within tree roots. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, savoring traditional Thai cuisine. Afterward, take a scenic longtail boat cruise along the Chao Phraya River, providing a relaxed view of Ayutthaya's riverside landscapes and historical surroundings. In the late afternoon, return to Bangkok for your overnight stay.

Activities: Visit Bang Pa-In Royal Palace; Explore Wat Yai Chai Mongkol; See Wat Phra Sri Sanphet; Visit Wat Mahathat; Enjoy lunch; Take a longtail boat cruise on Chao Phraya River; Return to Bangkok.

Day 18**Bangkok to Chiang Mai & Doi Suthep Temple***Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Chiang Mai*

Following breakfast, transfer to Bangkok Airport for your flight to Chiang Mai, the cultural heart of Northern Thailand. Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to your hotel for check-in. The morning is free for you to rest or begin exploring at your own pace.

In the afternoon, commence your Chiang Mai experience with a visit to Wat Phrathat Doi Suthep, one of the region's most sacred temples, perched high on Doi Suthep mountain. From this elevated position, enjoy expansive panoramic views of Chiang Mai city and the surrounding valleys. You have the option to ascend the iconic Naga Serpent Staircase or take a more relaxed cable car ride. The evening is free to independently explore Chiang Mai, perhaps joining an optional "Local Life - Chiang Mai Street Eats Evening Group Tour" or a "Khantoke Dinner with Show."

Activities: Transfer to Bangkok Airport; Fly to Chiang Mai; Transfer to Chiang Mai hotel; Check in; Visit Wat Phrathat Doi Suthep; Enjoy panoramic views; Free evening in Chiang Mai.

Day 19**Mae Sa Elephant Camp & Orchid Farm***Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Chiang Mai*

After breakfast, begin your journey to the picturesque Mae Sa Valley, an area characterized by lush tropical forests and refreshing mountain air. Your destination is the Mae Sa Elephant Camp, where you will have the opportunity to observe and interact with Thailand's gentle giants in a natural and ethically managed environment. Learn about their daily routines and enjoy respectful, close-up experiences.

On the return trip to Chiang Mai, you will pass by a beautiful orchid farm, offering a vibrant display of the region's rich floral cultivation. Return to your hotel in Chiang Mai, with the rest of the day at your leisure to relax or explore the city independently.

Activities: Travel to Mae Sa Valley; Visit Mae Sa Elephant Camp; Observe elephants; Pass by an orchid farm; Return to Chiang Mai; Free time.

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Day 20**Doi Inthanon National Park Trek & Waterfalls***Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Chiang Mai*

Following breakfast, depart by van for Doi Inthanon National Park, home to Thailand's highest peak and one of its most scenic natural areas. Embark on a gentle trek through the verdant mountain landscapes, enjoying sweeping views, refreshing forest trails, and the cool highland air at the summit. Continue your journey to a local Hill Tribe Village, where you can observe traditional ways of life within these mountain communities.

Visit one of the park's beautiful waterfalls, taking time to relax amidst the refreshing natural surroundings. A local-style lunch will be provided before you return to Chiang Mai in the late afternoon.

Activities: Travel to Doi Inthanon National Park; Trek through mountain landscapes; Visit Hill Tribe Village; See a waterfall; Enjoy local lunch; Return to Chiang Mai.

Day 21**Chiang Mai Departure***Meals: Breakfast | Stay: NA*

Enjoy your final breakfast at the hotel in Chiang Mai. Spend your last morning at leisure, perhaps revisiting a favorite spot or doing some last-minute souvenir shopping. At the scheduled time, a private transfer will take you to Chiang Mai Airport for your onward departure flight, concluding your extensive Indochina journey.
