The tour continues to the Temple of Literature, recognized as Vietnam's first national university. Here, you can wander through its tranquil courtyards and admire the stone stelae that chronicle the country's long-standing academic traditions. After enjoying lunch at a local restaurant, take a refreshing stroll around Hoan Kiem Lake, a central landmark popular with locals for relaxation and social gatherings.

The day concludes with a visit to Dong Xuan Market, Hanoi's largest indoor market. This bustling marketplace provides a vibrant glimpse into everyday urban life, with countless stalls offering everything from local produce and textiles to crafts and street food. After experiencing the lively atmosphere, you will be transferred back to your hotel.

Day 3

Ninh Binh Karst Landscapes & Ancient Capital

After breakfast at your Hanoi hotel, depart for Ninh Binh province, a region celebrated for its dramatic karst scenery and profound cultural heritage. Your first historical stop is Hoa Lu, Vietnam's former capital in the 10th century. Here, you'll explore the restored temples dedicated to the Dinh and Le dynasties, set against a backdrop of majestic mountains and showcasing early Vietnamese craftsmanship and architectural styles.

In the afternoon, experience the tranquility of the Ngo Dong River with a traditional sampan boat trip. Conclude your day with a visit to Bich Dong Pagoda, a historic temple complex built directly into a mountainside. Ascend the stone steps to explore its multiple levels and enjoy panoramic views of the surrounding valley before returning to your hotel in Hanoi.
