After docking, disembark to explore the village on foot, gaining deeper insights into the ingenuity and customs of the lake-dwelling communities. The journey continues with a visit to Les Artisans d'Angkor – Chantiers Ecoles, where skilled craftspeople demonstrate traditional Cambodian artistry, including wood carving, stone sculpture, and silk painting. This experience provides a profound appreciation for the nation's rich artistic heritage. Following your exploration, you will return to your hotel for an evening at your leisure.
