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complex showcases classic Angkorian architecture, featuring a central tower, elegant libraries, and decorative halls. Its serene setting and meticulous restoration work exemplify Khmer artistry at its peak.

In the afternoon, head to the shores of Tonle Sap Lake, Southeast Asia's largest freshwater lake, located about 16 kilometers from Siem Reap. Continue to Wat Bo Pagoda, one of Siem Reap's oldest and most revered temples. Founded in the 18th century, Wat Bo is famous for its beautiful 19th-century wall paintings depicting scenes from the Reamker, the Khmer version of the Ramayana. The tranquil atmosphere and historic charm make it a delightful stop before your departure.
