Day 1

Yangon Arrival & Colonial City Exploration

Meals: NA | Stay: Hotel in Yangon

Upon your arrival in Yangon, a local guide will meet you at the airport and facilitate your transfer to the hotel located in the city center. After completing check-in procedures, you will have some time to settle in or begin your independent exploration of this fascinating city. Please note that standard hotel check-in is typically after 2:00 PM.

Your guided city tour commences with a visit to the historic colonial district. You'll observe significant landmarks such as City Hall, Mahabandoola Park, and the Independence Monument. A drive along Strand Road will lead you past the bustling Yangon Jetty, offering glimpses into daily riverine trade. If time permits, a stop at the elegant Strand Hotel for refreshments can be arranged.

The afternoon continues with a visit to Botahtaung Pagoda, home to the revered Ahma Mya Nan Nwe shrine. Next, explore Bogyoke Aung San (Scott) Market, a popular destination for local handicrafts, jewelry, and diverse goods (closed on Mondays and public holidays). The day concludes with a visit to Chaukhtatgyi Pagoda, housing a massive reclining Buddha, a photo opportunity at Karaweik Hall on Royal Lake, and finally, the iconic Shwedagon Pagoda, where you can witness its golden stupa illuminate beautifully at sunset.

Activities: Arrive in Yangon and transfer to your hotel.

Explore the old colonial city center, including City Hall and Independence Monument.

Visit Botahtaung Pagoda and Ahma Mya Nan Nwe.

Browse local crafts at Bogyoke Aung San Market.

See the giant reclining Buddha at Chaukhtatgyi Pagoda.

Photograph Karaweik Hall on the Royal Lake.

Experience sunset at the Shwedagon Pagoda.

Day 2

Mandalay Monasteries & U Bein Bridge Sunset

Stay: Hotel in Mandalay | Transport: Airplane, Car

After enjoying breakfast at your hotel, you will be transferred to the airport for an early morning flight to Mandalay. Upon arrival, a driver will take you directly towards Amarapura. During the journey, you will stop to observe a traditional hand-weaving silk workshop, showcasing local craftsmanship.

In Amarapura, your cultural exploration begins at Mahagandayon Monastery, a prominent educational institution for young monks. Following this, you will visit the renowned U Bein Bridge, a 1.2-kilometer teakwood structure, historically recognized as one of the world's oldest and longest. This is a perfect spot to witness local life and the impressive engineering of a bygone

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The afternoon, around 1:00 PM, marks the start of your Mandalay city tour. The first stop is Mahamuni Pagoda, a significant Buddhist pilgrimage site famous for its gold-leaf-covered Buddha image. You'll then proceed to Mandalay Palace, the last royal residence of the Burmese monarchy, constructed entirely from teak. Further exploration includes Kuthodaw Pagoda, often called

This charming and authentic mode of transport allows you to leisurely pass by some of Bagan's most beautiful and ancient sites, offering a unique perspective on the timeless atmosphere of this historic city. The gentle pace provides ample opportunity to take in the vast landscape dotted with temples.

As evening approaches, you will board a cruise along the serene Ayeyarwaddy River. This river journey provides a spectacular vantage point to witness a breathtaking sunset over Bagan's iconic temple-filled plains. After this memorable experience on the water, you will return to your hotel for an overnight stay, reflecting on the day's discoveries.

Day 4**Bagan Temple Exploration & Sunset Views**

Your day in Bagan begins with a visit to the lively Nyaung U Market, where you can observe local life and commerce. Following this, you will explore some of Bagan's most significant pagodas, starting with the impressive Shwezigon Pagoda. The journey continues to Kyansittha Umin (Cave) and Gupaukgyi Temple, a 13th-century cave temple renowned for its intricate frescoes depicting tales from the Jataka stories.

In the afternoon, around 1:00 PM, your temple exploration resumes at Htilominlo Temple, built in 1211 A.D. by King

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Nantaungmya, known for its ancient murals and detailed friezes. You will then proceed to the elegant Ananda Temple, a stunning whitewashed architectural masterpiece showcasing four standing Buddha images and a blend of Mon and Indian influences.

Further visits include Thatbyinnyu Temple, Dhammayangyi Temple, and the area of Old Bagan, where you can admire grand ancient architecture and majestic Buddha statues. As the late afternoon arrives, make a stop at Shwesandaw Pagoda to enjoy a picturesque sunset over the vast plains dotted with countless temples. After the tour, you will return to your hotel for an overnight stay in Bagan.

Explore Shwezigon Pagoda, Kyansittha Umin, and Gupaukgyi Temple.

Discover Htilominlo Temple and Ananda Temple.

Day 5

After breakfast, you will be transferred to the airport for a domestic flight to Heho. Upon arrival, your journey into Myanmar's natural beauty begins. The first stop is Pindaya Cave, a remarkable limestone cavern filled with thousands of Buddha images, alongside the impressive Shwe U Min Paya complex located within the cave system. This site offers a unique blend of natural wonder and spiritual devotion.

Continue your exploration to the scenic Boutaloke Lake, enjoying the tranquil surroundings. You will also stop by a local handicraft workshop, famous for producing traditional Shan paper and umbrellas, providing insight into regional artisan traditions and an opportunity to purchase unique souvenirs.

In the afternoon, you will enjoy the fresh mountain air as you continue sightseeing at the base of Pindaya Hill. From here, you will be driven to Nyaung Shwe Jetty, where a boat will be waiting to transfer you to your hotel on Inle Lake. The evening offers a chance to relax and enjoy an overnight stay on the serene waters of the lake, surrounded by its unique stilt villages.

Activities: Fly from Bagan to Heho.

Visit Pindaya Cave and Shwe U Min Paya.

Explore Boutaloke Lake.

Stop at a local Shan paper and umbrella handicraft workshop.

Day 6

Inle Lake Boat Tour & Return to Yangon

At 8:00 AM, after breakfast at your hotel, you will embark on a comprehensive boat tour to discover the main attractions of Inle Lake and observe the daily routines of local communities. You may pass by a lively local market (on market days), situated at an elevation of 1,328 meters above sea level. This expansive lake, measuring 22 km long and 11 km wide, offers a fantastic

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opportunity to see how locals trade goods and sustain their livelihoods.

During the boat trip, you will witness the iconic one-legged rowing fishermen, a distinctive skill unique to the boatmen of Inle Lake. You'll also see the ingenious floating gardens, where vegetables are cultivated on buoyant beds. Your journey continues with visits to significant cultural and craft sites, including the revered Phaungdaw Oo Pagoda, the Inphawkhon Silk Weaving Village, the unique Burmese Cats House, cheroot-making workshops, and other traditional cottage industries.

The final stop is Nga Phe Kyaung Monastery, a beautiful 200-year-old teak monastery built on stilts over the lake. At the conclusion of the tour, you will be transferred to Heho Airport for your flight back to Yangon. Upon arrival, a transfer will take you to your hotel for check-in and an overnight stay.

Next, you will see the One Pillar Pagoda, one of Vietnam's most iconic temples, recognized for its unique architecture resembling a lotus blossom. You will also view the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum from outside, observing the historic father figure's resting place and his humble house on stilts (note: the Mausoleum is closed on Mondays, Fridays, and from June to August).

The journey continues to the picturesque West Lake and the Tran Quoc Buddhist Pagoda, a sixth-century structure where you can delve deeper into Vietnamese Buddhism. The tour concludes at an authentic Vietnamese restaurant, where you will have the opportunity to sample some of the country's delicious cuisine. The remainder of the day is free for you to relax or explore Hanoi independently, with an overnight stay in the city.

Following a crucial safety briefing, you will embark on a leisurely cruise around Halong Bay. A delicious lunch featuring local seafood will be served on board as you marvel at the breathtaking scenery of towering limestone islands and dramatic grottoes emerging from the clear, emerald waters. This is a perfect opportunity to relax and soak in the majestic seascape.

Next, board a motorized boat for a picturesque trip along the legendary Mekong River. You will drift past traditional stilt houses, active floating fish farms, and lush riverbanks before reaching Tortoise Island, where you will experience the charm of local delta life. Here, you will learn about the unique "Garden-Pond-Cage" agricultural system and enjoy delightful tastings of coconut candy and honey tea, prepared by friendly locals.

Glide through tranquil, shaded canals lined with water-coconut trees aboard a traditional sampan boat, offering a moment of pure Mekong enchantment. You will then stop for a delicious Vietnamese lunch at a local restaurant, followed by some free time to explore or even cycle around the village for a closer look at rural life. In the afternoon, continue your boat trip to discover tropical fruit orchards and enjoy a lively performance of Southern Vietnamese folk music.
