DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Day 1

Hanoi to Ha Giang's Karst Plateau & Dong Van

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Stay: Hotel in Dong Van

The journey commences with a transfer from Hanoi, leading into the dramatic mountainous terrain of Ha Giang. Travelers can select between a comfortable limousine bus departing from Hanoi Old Quarter in the afternoon or a luxury private cabin on an overnight sleeper bus for a more relaxed start. Upon arrival in Ha Giang, the landscape quickly transforms into winding mountain roads.

The first significant stop is Bac Sum Slope, offering expansive views, followed by a scenic drive towards Quan Ba Town. The route passes through the UNESCO-recognized Dong Van Karst Plateau Geopark, characterized by its unique limestone formations and terraced fields, showcasing authentic rural life in the northern highlands. After a local lunch in Yen Minh Town, the afternoon continues towards Dong Van, with highlights including traversing the scenic Tham Ma Slope and visiting the historic H'mong King Palace, a significant cultural site reflecting the region's heritage. The day concludes with arrival in Dong Van Town, where a hearty dinner awaits.

Activities: Transfer from Hanoi to Ha Giang by bus.
Enjoy panoramic views from Bac Sum Slope.
Drive through Dong Van Karst Plateau Geopark.
Visit Quan Ba Heaven Gate and Twin Mountains.
Explore the historic H'mong King Palace.
Arrive and dine in Dong Van Town.

Day 2

Ma Pi Leng Pass, Meo Vac & Overnight Transfer to Sapa

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Stay: Hotel in Sapa

Following breakfast in Dong Van, the tour embarks on the iconic Ma Pi Leng Pass, often hailed as Vietnam's most spectacular mountain road. This legendary route, part of the Happiness Road, offers breathtaking vistas from an altitude of 2,000 meters, winding along sheer cliffs. Travelers descend the narrow Sky Path, carved into the mountainside, to gain unparalleled panoramic views of the Nho Que River's emerald waters and the deep canyons below. This segment provides exceptional photographic opportunities amidst dramatic natural beauty.

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The journey continues through remote villages like Lung Ho, Mau Due, and Meo Vac, offering glimpses into isolated highland communities. After lunch in Meo Vac, the adventure proceeds towards Du Gia Village, known for its diverse ethnic groups. Here, an authentic homestay experience with a Tay minority family includes a traditional dinner and a cultural toast, immersing travelers in rural mountain life. Later in the afternoon, the return journey towards Ha Giang City begins, followed by a comfortable limousine bus transfer to Sapa, arriving late in the evening.

- Activities:** Drive the legendary Ma Pi Leng Pass.
Descend the Sky Path for Nho Que River views.
Explore remote villages like Lung Ho, Mau Due, Meo Vac.
Enjoy a traditional lunch in Meo Vac.
Experience a Tay minority homestay in Du Gia (dinner included).
Transfer by limousine bus from Ha Giang to Sapa.

Day 3

Sapa Trekking, Fansipan Ascent & Return to Hanoi

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: NA

The day begins with a hearty breakfast in Sapa before embarking on a captivating trek through the Muong Hoa Valley. The 6-kilometer hike leads to Y Linh Ho Village, a Black H'mong community surrounded by misty hills and bamboo forests, offering insights into local culture. The trail then continues for 3 kilometers to Lao Chai Village, another H'mong settlement along the Muong Hoa River, where lunch is shared with a local family amidst rice paddies. The trek concludes in Ta Van Village, home to the Giay ethnic group, known for its stilt houses and scenic views before returning to Sapa.

In the afternoon, travelers proceed to the Fansipan Cable Car Station. Ascend to the "Roof of Indochina," Mount Fansipan, at 3,143 meters. The 20-minute cable car ride offers breathtaking views of the Hoang Lien Son mountain range. A stop at Kim Son Bao Thang Tu Pagoda provides a serene interlude before climbing the final 600 steps to the summit for a 360-degree panorama. After absorbing the majestic views, descend by cable car and begin the road transfer back to Hanoi, concluding the highland adventure.

- Activities:** Trek to Y Linh Ho Village (Black H'mong).
Hike to Lao Chai Village for lunch with a local family.
Explore Ta Van Village (Giay ethnic group).
Ascend Mount Fansipan via cable car.
Visit Kim Son Bao Thang Tu Pagoda.
Conquer the 600 steps to Fansipan summit.
Transfer by road from Sapa back to Hanoi.
