DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Day 1

Hanoi Departure & Lan Ha Bay Cruise Exploration

Meals: Lunch, Dinner | Stay: Deluxe Cruise | Transport: Limousine bus, Tender boat, Cruise ship

After morning pick-up from Hanoi Old Quarter hotels, travelers embark on a scenic journey towards Tuan Chau Harbor. Upon arrival, a tender transfers guests to their main cruise vessel, where a warm welcome awaits. A cruise manager provides a safety briefing and introduction while guests enjoy a refreshing drink before settling into their cabins. Lunch is served as the boat begins its serene navigation through the less crowded waters of Lan Ha Bay, an extension of the famous Halong Bay. The route passes iconic formations like Finger Islet and Candle Islet, surrounded by countless limestone karsts.

In the afternoon, the adventure continues with an exploration of Tra Bau Area, renowned as a filming location for "Kong Skull Island." Here, guests can enjoy kayaking and swimming in the pristine waters. As evening approaches, return to the cruise for a relaxing "Sunset Party" and "Happy Hour," offering a magical atmosphere as the sun dips below the horizon. A luxurious Gala Dinner is served on the sundeck, featuring fresh ingredients and a blend of French neo-classical and traditional Asian culinary styles. The evening concludes with various activities such as a herbal foot bath, bamboo dance, an ethnic fashion show, or squid fishing under the peaceful night sky.

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Day 2**Lan Ha Bay Caves & Overnight Train to Sapa***Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Overnight Sleeper Train | Transport: Cruise ship, Transfer boat, Limousine bus, Overnight train*

The day begins early with an optional Tai Chi session on the sundeck, offering a tranquil start amidst the stunning bay scenery. A light breakfast of tea, coffee, and other refreshments is served as the cruise continues its journey past impressive karst formations. Shortly after, guests prepare for an excursion to the Dark and Bright Cave, an area celebrated for its untouched natural beauty and picturesque seascape. Visitors will navigate these caves by bamboo boat, providing an intimate experience of the limestone mountains and the clear blue waters of Lan Ha Bay, perfect for photography.

After returning to the main vessel, check-out procedures are completed. A well-prepared brunch is served as the cruise slowly makes its way back towards Tuan Chau Harbor, offering final views of the emerald waters and thousands of karst peaks. Upon disembarking at Tuan Chau Marina, a transfer bus awaits to take guests back to Hanoi. The afternoon allows for free time in Hanoi to relax, explore the Old Quarter, or do some shopping. In the evening, a transfer will take travelers to the train station for an overnight journey to Sapa, traveling in a deluxe air-conditioned cabin with four soft berths, arriving at Lao Cai Train Station the following morning.

Day 3**Sapa Arrival & Trekking Cat Cat and Sin Chai Villages***Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: 3-star Hotel | Transport: Shuttle bus/16-seater Ford Transit, Walking, Car*

Early morning marks the arrival at Lao Cai Train Station, where a local representative will meet and transfer travelers to Sapa Town. The scenic drive to Sapa takes approximately one hour, offering initial glimpses of the mountainous terrain. Upon reaching Sapa, guests can enjoy breakfast at a local restaurant and freshen up before the day's trekking adventure begins. An English-speaking tour guide will then lead the group on a trek down into the valley towards Cat Cat Village, a settlement of the Black Hmong people, about 4 km from Sapa.

During the walk, participants will observe an old French hydro-electric power station and witness local villagers working in the paddy fields, with children playing and various farm animals roaming freely. After crossing a village, the trail leads to a beautiful waterfall, providing a perfect spot for rest and photos. Later in the afternoon, the hike continues to Sin Chai Village, nestled at the base of Mount Fansipan. A picnic lunch is enjoyed in Sin Chai, surrounded by peaceful natural scenery. Afterwards, a car will transport the group back to Sapa town, allowing for free time in the evening to explore, shop, and dine independently before spending the night in a Sapa hotel.

Activities: Arrival at Lao Cai Train Station and transfer to Sapa.
Breakfast and refreshment in Sapa.
Trekking to Cat Cat Village.

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Visiting an old French hydro-electric power station.

Observing local life and paddy fields.

Visiting a waterfall in Cat Cat Village.

Hiking to Sin Chai Village.

Enjoying a picnic lunch in Sin Chai Village.

Returning to Sapa town by car.

Free time in Sapa for exploration and dinner.

Day 4**Sapa Valley Trek: Lao Chai, Ta Van & Return Overnight Train**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Overnight Sleeper Train | Transport: Walking, Car, Overnight train

Wake up to the fresh Sapa air and enjoy breakfast at the hotel, savoring the morning tranquility. An English-speaking guide will then pick up guests to commence another day of trekking through the stunning Sapa valleys. The trek leads through a bamboo forest, eventually reaching Ta Van Village, home to the Giay ethnic minority. Here, travelers can explore the village and gain insight into the local way of life.

Lunch is served at a local house situated near the picturesque Muong Hoa River. In the afternoon, the journey continues to Lao Chai Village, a vibrant community of the Black Hmong people. This area offers spectacular views of Sapa's extensive terraced rice fields, providing ample photo opportunities. The trek then proceeds to Y Linh Ho Village before ascending to the main road, where a car awaits to transfer the group back to their Sapa hotel. The late afternoon is free for personal activities such as freshening up, last-minute shopping, or enjoying an early dinner. In the early evening, a transfer takes travelers downhill to Lao Cai station to board the overnight sleeper train back to Hanoi, sharing a deluxe cabin with four soft berths.

Trekking through bamboo forest to Ta Van Village.
Exploring Ta Van Village.
Having lunch at a local house by Muong Hoa River.
Continuing trek to Lao Chai Village.
Enjoying views of Sapa's largest rice terraces.

Transferring to Lao Cai train station.
Overnight train journey from Sapa to Hanoi.

Day 5**Ninh Binh's Spiritual & Natural Wonders: Bai Dinh & Trang An**

Meals: Lunch, Dinner | Stay: Homestay | Transport: Transfer bus, Boat

After an early morning arrival back in Hanoi by train, travelers will be picked up from their hotel in the Old Quarter for a transfer to Ninh Binh. A short break is scheduled en route for stretching and refreshments. The first major destination in Ninh Binh is Bai Dinh Pagoda, a renowned spiritual complex famous for its extensive collection of Buddhist statues and impressive architecture. Visitors can admire the 500 stone Arhat statues, a massive 27-ton bell tower, and a golden statue of the Goddess of Mercy, among other significant features.

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Lunch features local Ninh Binh specialties, served in a private area at the Trang An Eco Holiday Retreat, with vegetarian options available. In the afternoon, the journey continues to the Trang An Grottoes, a UNESCO World Heritage site celebrated for its majestic limestone cliffs, mysterious caves, and serene waterways. A boat trip of approximately 2.5 hours allows exploration of the cave complex, including Sang Cave, Toi Cave, Ba Giot Cave, and Nau Ruou Cave, offering breathtaking natural beauty. Following the boat trip, guests check into their bungalow or hotel for some personal relaxation or a swim before enjoying dinner. The evening is free, with no tour guide services until the next morning.

Day 6

Hoa Lu, Tam Coc & Mua Cave Panorama, Return to Hanoi

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: null | Transport: Transfer bus, Boat

Start the final day with breakfast at the homestay or hotel, followed by some free time to explore the immediate surroundings of Ninh Binh. Around late morning, the tour begins with a visit to Hoa Lu, the ancient capital of Vietnam during the Dinh and Le dynasties. Here, travelers can explore the historic temples dedicated to these kings, gaining insights into the region's rich history and cultural heritage.

Lunch is served at a local restaurant, featuring delicious regional cuisine. In the afternoon, the journey continues to Tam Coc, famously known as "Halong Bay on Land" due to its striking limestone karst formations and intricate waterways. A boat ride through Tam Coc offers a chance to admire the stunning natural scenery and observe the daily life of local residents along the river. The adventure culminates with a hike up Mua Cave, involving over 500 steps to the summit of Ngoa Long Mountain. From this vantage point, visitors are rewarded with a spectacular panoramic view of Ninh Binh City and the winding Ngo Dong River below. After soaking in the views, guests board the bus for the return trip to Hanoi, arriving at their hotel in the early evening, marking the conclusion of the tour.
