Route at a Glance

Your journey begins with an overnight train from Hanoi to Lao Cai. From there, you'll transfer to Sapa and immediately delve into the Muong Hoa Valley, trekking through Lao Chai, Ta Van, and spending a night in Giang Ta Chai. Day two continues with exploration of Ban Ho before returning to a hotel in Sapa. The final day features an excursion to Fansipan Peak, followed by a comfortable limousine bus ride back to Hanoi.

Traveler Profile

This tour is ideal for active travelers who appreciate immersive cultural experiences and scenic trekking. Participants should be comfortable with moderate to long walks over varied terrain and open to the simplicity of a village homestay. It caters to those eager to connect with local traditions and witness awe-inspiring mountain landscapes.

Essential Information

Accommodation includes a night in a traditional homestay and a night in a Sapa hotel, with options for different comfort levels. All major transfers, including the overnight train and Fansipan cable car, are arranged. Meals are provided as indicated in the itinerary. An English-speaking local guide accompanies you throughout the trekking and village visits, offering insights into the local culture and environment.

DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Day 1

Sapa Arrival & Muong Hoa Valley Trek to Giang Ta Chai

Meals: B, L, D | Stay: Homestay in Giang Ta Chai Village | Transport: Bus, Walking

Your journey commences with an early morning arrival at Lao Cai Train Station. A bus will then transfer you to Sapa town, where you can enjoy breakfast and refresh yourself at a local restaurant in the town center. Following this, a bus will take you to Lao Chai village, marking the start of your trekking adventure. Here, you'll be treated to magnificent views of terraced rice fields stretching along the Muong Hoa River, with opportunities to encounter local H'mong and Dao ethnic groups along the way.

You'll then follow a local path to Lao Chai, a traditional H'mong village, before continuing your walk to Ta Van village, home to the Day ethnic community. After enjoying a local lunch, you'll have some free time to observe and learn about the daily life of the ethnic villagers in Ta Van. The afternoon involves a scenic trek along the Muong Hoa Valley towards Giang Ta Chai Village, inhabited by the Red Dao hill tribe. This walk takes you through more stunning terraced rice fields and tranquil bamboo forests. Upon reaching Giang Ta Chai, you'll check into your homestay with a Red Dao family, have dinner, and spend the evening exploring the village at your leisure.

Activities: Arrive at Lao Cai Train Station
Transfer by bus to Sapa
Enjoy breakfast and shower at a local restaurant
Transfer by bus to Lao Chai village
Trek through Lao Chai village, observing H'mong ethnic life
Continue walking to Ta Van village, meeting Day ethnic people
Have lunch at a local restaurant in Ta Van
Explore the ethnic life in Ta Van village
Trek along Muong Hoa Valley to Giang Ta Chai Village
Walk through terraced rice fields and bamboo forest
Check into a Red Dao homestay in Giang Ta Chai
Enjoy dinner at the homestay
Explore Giang Ta Chai village

Day 2**Ban Ho Village Exploration & Return to Sapa***Meals: B, L | Stay: Hotel in Sapa Center | Transport: Walking, Private car*

After a hearty breakfast at your Giang Ta Chai homestay, you will embark on a walk along the village road, continuing your journey through the picturesque Muong Hoa Valley. This scenic route leads you towards Ban Ho Village, a settlement where the Tay ethnic people reside. Along the way, there will be several opportunities to pause and capture photographs of the stunning mountain scenery that surrounds you.

Upon your arrival in Ban Ho Village, your knowledgeable tour guide will lead you on a visit to some of the distinctive stilt houses that are characteristic of the Tay ethnic community. This provides a unique chance to gain insight into their daily routines, traditions, and way of life. Following this cultural immersion, you will enjoy a delicious lunch at a local restaurant within the village. In the afternoon, a private car will transfer you comfortably back to your hotel situated in Sapa Center. After checking into your accommodation, the remainder of the day is yours to spend at leisure, perhaps exploring Sapa town or simply relaxing after your trek.

Activities: Enjoy breakfast at the homestay
Walk along the village road through Muong Hoa Valley
Trek to Ban Ho Village
Take short breaks to photograph mountain scenery
Visit traditional stilt houses of the Tay ethnic group
Discover the daily life of the Tay people
Have lunch at a local restaurant in Ban Ho
Transfer by private car back to Sapa Center
Check into your Sapa hotel
Enjoy leisure time in Sapa

Day 3**Fansipan Peak Ascent & Return to Hanoi***Meals: B | Transport: Mountain train, Cable car, Limousine bus*

Following breakfast at your hotel, your tour guide will accompany you to the Sunworld Mountain Train Station. From here, you will board a mountain train that ascends to the Cable Car Station, offering initial views of the surrounding landscapes. Upon reaching the cable car station, you will transfer to a cable car, beginning your breathtaking journey towards Fansipan Peak. This peak, standing at 3143 meters above sea level, is the highest point in Indochina.

The cable car ride itself provides spectacular aerial views of the Hoang Lien Son mountain range and the cloud-kissed valleys below. Once at Fansipan Peak, you'll have ample time to marvel at the expansive, awe-inspiring scenery from the "Roof of Indochina." After soaking in the panoramic vistas and capturing memorable photographs, you will descend back down by cable car and then the mountain train. Returning to your hotel, you will complete the check-out process. In the early afternoon, a comfortable limousine bus will be waiting to transfer you directly back to Hanoi, concluding your Sapa adventure as you arrive at your hotel in the capital city around 19:30.

Activities: Enjoy breakfast at the hotel
Transfer to Sunworld Mountain Train Station
Ride the mountain train to the Cable Car Station

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Take the cable car to Fansipan Peak
Enjoy amazing scenery from Fansipan Peak (3143m)
Descend by cable car and mountain train
Return to hotel for check-out
Transfer by limousine bus back to Hanoi
Arrive at your hotel in Hanoi
