Day 2

Bangkok's Grand Palaces & Temples

Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Overnight in Bangkok

Your day of discovery begins around 08:00, meeting your guide at MRT Sanamchai Exit 1 (Museum Siam Exit). Please arrive 15 minutes early for a prompt start. The first stop is Wat Pho, one of Thailand's oldest and largest temples, renowned for its

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impressive gold-leaf-covered Reclining Buddha. You'll have time to explore the expansive courtyards and halls, home to over a thousand Buddha images that reflect centuries of Thai artistry. The journey continues to the Grand Palace, a former royal residence showcasing a harmonious blend of Thai and European architectural styles. Wander through the ornate grounds, appreciating the exquisite craftsmanship of traditional Thai-Buddhist structures that symbolize the monarchy's deep connection to national identity. Within the palace complex, you will also visit Wat Phra Kaew, which houses the revered Emerald Buddha, discovered in 1434.

Afterward, experience a traditional tuk-tuk ride, passing significant Bangkok landmarks like the City Pillar Shrine and the Ministry of Defence. The final destination is Kor Panich, a legendary dessert shop famous for its authentic mango sticky rice, a beloved Thai treat perfected through an 80-year-old family recipe. At the tour's conclusion, your guide can suggest local street food spots or assist with directions back to your hotel. Please remember to wear respectful clothing—long pants, closed-heel shoes, and sleeved tops are required for temple entry.

Day 4**Ancient Angkor Thom & Angkor Wat Discovery**

After being picked up from your hotel in the morning, your exploration begins with Angkor Thom, the final capital of the Khmer Empire. You will enter through the South Gate, where imposing stone faces create a powerful first impression. Next, marvel at Bayon Temple, with its intricate carvings depicting historical and mythological scenes of Khmer life. Your guide will then lead you to the Elephant Terrace, a grand stage once used by ancient kings for important events, and nearby, the Terrace of the Leper King, adorned with fascinating bas-reliefs that invite curiosity and interpretation.

In the afternoon, the journey continues to the magnificent Angkor Wat, recognized as the world's most extensive religious monument and a profound symbol of Cambodia. Constructed in the 12th century, this masterpiece of classical Khmer art and

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architecture invites you to wander through its galleries and lose yourself in incredible artwork that narrates tales from the past. As the day concludes, you will return to your hotel, filled with memories of these ancient wonders.

Take time to capture photos of these significant moments. After your explorations, you will enjoy a delicious meal at a nearby restaurant, savoring traditional Vietnamese cuisine.

Day 7**Halong Bay Cruise & Island Exploration**

Between 08:00 and 08:30 this morning, a driver will pick you up from your hotel in Hanoi's Old Quarter for the transfer via the new Hanoi - Hai Phong Expressway to the ferry port. Upon arrival at Halong Bay, you will board your cruise ship, where you'll be welcomed with a refreshing drink and a brief safety orientation from the crew. As the vessel sails past stunning rock formations into this natural heritage site, you will enjoy a delicious lunch at the upscale onboard restaurant.

In the afternoon, you might consider reserving a relaxing massage or spa treatment (reservations recommended).

Subsequently, you will climb over 50 steps to enter Sung Sot Cave, gazing upon its enormous chambers adorned with beautiful stalagmites and stalactites, along with views of lush vegetation around the entrance. Your journey continues to Ti Top Island, a crescent-shaped island known for its tranquil atmosphere and pristine waters. You can spend 1 to 2 hours ascending to the summit for a breathtaking 360-degree panorama of Halong Bay or simply enjoy a swim at the beach.

As evening approaches, you'll have the opportunity to participate in a cultural activity, such as a traditional Vietnamese cooking class or a fruit and vegetable carving demonstration, a signature experience on most overnight Halong Bay cruises. Afterward, a delightful dinner will be served on board. Optional evening activities include night squid fishing, playing board games or cards, or simply relaxing at the bar and embracing the peaceful ambiance. Back onboard, savor a hearty brunch as the cruise slowly makes its way toward the harbor. Use this time to pack your belongings or soak up the final moments on the sundeck. In the afternoon, disembark at Tuan Chau Port and meet your driver for the return transfer to Hanoi.
