Day 1	Siem Reap Arrival & Leisure <i>Meals: Breakfast Stay: Hotel in Siem Reap Transport: Airport transfer by private vehicle</i> Upon your arrival at Siem Reap International Airport, a friendly local guide and driver will be waiting to provide a smooth transfer to your hotel. After checking in, you'll have ample time to settle into your accommodation and relax following your travels. The remainder of your first day in Cambodia is dedicated to personal leisure, allowing you to acclimate to the local time and prepare for the exciting explorations ahead. Day 2	Angkor Thom, Bayon, Ta Prohm & Siem Reap Countryside

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Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Siem Reap | Transport: Tuk-tuk, private vehicle

Your morning begins with a tuk-tuk ride to the ancient walled city of Angkor Thom, the last capital of the Khmer Empire. Inside, you'll encounter the enigmatic Bayon Temple, famous for its 39 towers adorned with serene, smiling faces that create a mystical atmosphere. Continue through Angkor Thom to admire the detailed bas-reliefs on the Terrace of the Elephants and the Terrace of the Leper King, which depict historical events and mythical figures. You might also discover lesser-known shrines within the former Royal Palace grounds, offering a glimpse into the grandeur of a bygone era.

Next, explore the captivating Ta Prohm Temple, where colossal tree roots and jungle vines have dramatically intertwined with the ancient stone structures, creating a truly unique and atmospheric scene, famously featured in the Tomb Raider film.

Alternatively, you could visit the sprawling Preah Khan temple complex, known for its labyrinthine passages and intricate carvings, offering a more intimate experience away from larger crowds, especially during peak season.

After a local lunch, venture into the countryside for a cultural immersion. Visit a bustling local market, where you can practice basic Khmer phrases with vendors. Later, undertake a climb of 635 steps up Phnom Bok Mountain for stunning panoramic views of rice paddies and villages. Enjoy a refreshing coconut and another Khmer language lesson at the summit, surrounded by ancient temple ruins and a tranquil Buddhist pagoda. Conclude your day at an evening street market, experiencing the vibrant local entertainment and cuisine.

Activities: Tuk-tuk ride to Angkor Thom; Visit Bayon Temple; Explore Terrace of the Elephants; Discover Terrace of the Leper King; Tour Ta Prohm Temple (or Preah Khan); Lunch at local restaurant; Visit a local market; Climb Phnom Bok Mountain; Explore temple ruins and pagoda; Visit evening street market

Day 3**Rural Cambodian Life & Tonle Sap Floating Village***Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Siem Reap | Transport: Private vehicle, ox cart, boat*

Start your day with a 25-minute drive to Ta Brak Village, where you'll be welcomed by a local family. Share a simple Western-style breakfast and engage in conversations, gaining insights into their daily routines and community life. Following breakfast, board an ox cart for a leisurely 30-minute ride to a vibrant local market, where you can observe the lively trade of fresh produce and spices. A 1-kilometer walk through the scenic countryside reveals rice fields and sugar palm trees, offering a glimpse into Cambodia's timeless rural landscape. You might see locals weaving thatch roofs or tending to crops, depending on the season, highlighting the deep connection between the people and their land. The morning concludes with a traditional water blessing from saffron-robed monks at a peaceful local pagoda.

In the afternoon, pause at the impressive 9th-century Bakong Temple, a significant part of the Roluos group and a former center of the Khmer civilization. Its tiered pyramidal structure and weathered carvings provide a window into early Khmer architectural prowess. Later, embark on a boat journey across the vast Tonle Sap Lake, Southeast Asia's largest freshwater lake and a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve. Glide towards Kampong Phluk, a less-frequented floating village nestled within a flooded mangrove forest. A ride in a traditional wooden boat allows you to observe the unique lifestyle of fishermen and their families who live in harmony with the water, offering a truly immersive cultural experience.

Activities: Visit Ta Brak Village; Share breakfast with a local family; Ox cart ride to local market; Countryside walk; Water blessing at local pagoda; Visit Bakong Temple; Boat journey on Tonle Sap Lake; Explore Kampong Phluk floating village

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Day 4

Flight to Hanoi & Old Quarter Culinary Exploration

After breakfast, you will transfer to Siem Reap International Airport for your flight to Hanoi, the captivating capital of Vietnam. Upon arrival, a driver will meet you and transfer you to your hotel for check-in. Prepare to dive straight into the city's renowned culinary scene.

As evening approaches, around 17:30, your guide will lead you into the vibrant, narrow alleyways of Hanoi's Old Quarter. This bustling area is a sensory delight, filled with the aromas of simmering broths and sizzling woks. Your culinary adventure begins with Vietnam's most cherished comfort foods, such as the fragrant Pho Bo (Vietnamese Beef Noodles), the delicate Bun Thang (Rice Vermicelli Noodles with Chicken and Egg), or the rich, spicy Bun Bo Hue. You'll enjoy these dishes alongside locals, experiencing the authentic street food culture.

Continue your gastronomic journey by sampling Banh Cuon, delicate steamed rice rolls filled with minced pork and mushrooms, followed by a crispy Banh Mi, a French-influenced baguette packed with savory fillings and fresh vegetables. Each bite tells a story of Hanoi's diverse culinary heritage. As you explore deeper, taste irresistible street snacks like Nom Bo Kho (Dried Beef Salad) or Nem Chua Ran (Fried Fermented Pork Rolls), often enjoyed casually on small stools. The evening culminates with the unique Ca Phe Trung (Egg Coffee), a creamy, rich concoction enjoyed in a cozy Hanoi café, providing a sweet and memorable conclusion to your flavorful exploration of the city's night markets.

The tour starts with a visit to the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum Complex, where you'll gain insights into the life and legacy of Vietnam's revered leader. Stroll through the serene gardens to see his humble stilt house and admire the grand Presidential Palace, understanding the principles that shaped modern Vietnam.

Next, marvel at the elegant One Pillar Pagoda, a small yet iconic temple gracefully rising from a single wooden pillar above a lotus pond. This centuries-old structure is celebrated for its beauty and its spiritual symbolism of purity. Continue to the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first national university and an enduring symbol of Confucian scholarship. Walk through ancient gateways, admire traditional courtyards, and reflect on the generations of scholars who once studied here, leaving a profound cultural legacy.

To complete your tour, enjoy an authentic Vietnamese meal at a local restaurant. Between 07:30 and 08:00, your guide will collect you from your hotel for a scenic 120 km journey by comfortable Limousine bus through Vietnam's picturesque countryside. Arriving at Hoa Lu Ancient Citadel around 10:30, you'll step back in time to the 10th century, when this site served as Vietnam's first capital. Recognized by UNESCO as a cultural heritage destination, Hoa Lu was a crucial stronghold where early dynasties defended the nation's independence. Explore the venerable Dinh King Temple, dating back to the 17th century, adorned with intricate wood and stone carvings that reflect the artistry and devotion of its era.

At 12:00, enjoy a hearty lunch at a local restaurant, savoring authentic regional specialties that highlight the distinct flavors of Ninh Binh. The afternoon, around 14:00, features a peaceful sampan boat ride along the Ngo Dong River, skillfully rowed by locals. As your boat glides through emerald waters, you'll admire endless rice paddies framed by towering limestone cliffs, a landscape often likened to

Between 08:00 and 08:30, a driver will pick you up from your Hanoi Old Quarter hotel, commencing your scenic journey along the modern Hanoi - Hai Phong Expressway towards the Gulf of Tonkin. This drive sets the stage for an extraordinary adventure as you approach the emerald waters and majestic limestone karsts of Ha Long Bay.

Upon arrival, you will board your luxurious Ha Long Bay cruise. A welcoming drink awaits as you receive a warm introduction, a comprehensive cruise briefing, and essential safety instructions. Soon after, a delectable lunch will be served at the onboard restaurant while the vessel gracefully navigates past dramatic karst formations, immersing you in the breathtaking scenery of this UNESCO World Heritage Site.

In the afternoon, you can choose to unwind with rejuvenating spa and massage treatments (reservations recommended). For those seeking adventure, ascend over 50 stone steps to explore the legendary Sung Sot (Surprise) Cave. Inside one of Ha Long Bay's largest grottoes, marvel at the dramatic stalactites and stalagmites illuminated in vibrant colors, creating an otherworldly underground landscape. As dusk approaches, participate in a lively Vietnamese cooking demonstration on deck, learning to craft spring rolls or carve fruits while watching the sun set over the horizon, painting the limestone peaks in hues of gold and crimson. The evening concludes with a sumptuous dinner served onboard, blending authentic Vietnamese flavors with refined presentation. Afterward, you can try squid fishing, play board games, or simply relax at the bar under a starlit sky before retiring to your cozy cabin, lulled by the gentle lapping of the bay's waters.

Here, you can climb to the island's observation platform for a sweeping 360-degree panorama of Ha Long Bay, with its dramatic limestone cliffs rising from emerald seas. Alternatively, relax on the beach, swim, or simply enjoy the soft sand. Back on board, a delightful brunch is served as the vessel slowly makes its way back to the harbor. Use this time to savor your final moments on the sundeck, pack your belongings, or simply bask in the breathtaking scenery.

By midday, the ship arrives at Tuan Chau Port, concluding your unforgettable Ha Long journey. You will disembark and relax while awaiting your transfer to the airport. Catch your flight to Ho Chi Minh City, the bustling southern metropolis brimming with energy, history, and culinary delights. Upon landing, your driver will escort you to your hotel for check-in, marking the beginning of your southern Vietnam adventure.

After breakfast, your journey begins at Batubulan Village, where you'll witness the creation of traditional handmade Batik Painting, brought to life with vibrant colors and intricate patterns. Observe skilled artisans transforming plain fabric into storytelling canvases, each design reflecting Balinese culture and spirituality. Continue to Mas Village, a renowned center for painting and wood carving. Here, the rhythmic tapping of chisels and the scent of freshly carved wood fill the air as local artists create sacred figures and cultural motifs with remarkable precision.

Your next stop is a scenic Coffee Plantation, nestled amidst lush highlands. Learn about various coffee varieties, including the famous Luwak coffee. Walk through rows of coffee trees, discover the traditional roasting process, and delight your senses with on-site tastings of rich Indonesian blends. The highlight of the day unfolds at Mount Batur and Lake Batur, offering sweeping views of the volcanic peak and its serene sister lake. While admiring the breathtaking landscape, savor an authentic Indonesian buffet lunch at a local restaurant.

On your return, pause at Tegalalang Village, where spectacular rice terraces cascade down emerald-green slopes in harmonious layers. The tranquil beauty of these terraces captures the timeless bond between Balinese farmers and their land. The tour continues to Ubud Handicraft Village, where creativity thrives in every workshop and boutique. Here, you'll also enjoy a complimentary visit to the Ubud Royal Palace, a cultural gem located near the bustling Ubud Market. Stroll through the vibrant stalls filled with handicrafts, textiles, and souvenirs—perfect treasures to bring home as memories of your Balinese journey.

After breakfast, transfer to Sanur Beach to board a public fast boat across the Bali Sea towards Nusa Penida. The morning ride offers refreshing sea breezes and shimmering waters, setting the tone for a day of discovery. The boat departs at either 07:00 or 08:00, arriving around 09:30 at Toyapakeh Pier, the gateway to this island paradise.

Your adventure begins at Angel Billabong, a natural infinity pool carved by the ocean, where turquoise waters glisten under the sun. Witness waves dramatically crashing against the rocks before flowing into this hidden lagoon, creating a breathtaking scene of untamed beauty. Just a short walk away lies Broken Beach (Pantai Pasih Uug), the remnants of a collapsed cave

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forming a natural stone arch over the sea. Standing at the edge, you'll be mesmerized by the circular cove filled with swirling ocean waters—an extraordinary spectacle shaped by time and tide.

Afterward, enjoy a complimentary Indonesian set lunch at a local restaurant before heading to Kelingking Beach Secret Point, one of Nusa Penida's most iconic spots. From the clifftop, marvel at the unique rock formation resembling a T-Rex resting by the ocean, with emerald waves lapping against the golden shore far below. Note that swimming and access to the beach are restricted here, but it offers incredible photo opportunities. The journey continues to Crystal Bay, a tropical haven renowned for its crystal-clear waters and thriving marine life. Slip into your swimsuit for a refreshing swim or snorkel amidst colorful coral reefs teeming with vibrant fish. As the day winds down, return to Buyuk Penida Pier to catch the fast boat back to Bali. Upon arrival at Sanur Beach, a transfer will take you back to your hotel, carrying vivid memories of one of Bali's most stunning islands.

Activities: Transfer to Sanur Beach; Fast boat to Nusa Penida; Visit Angel Billabong; Explore Broken Beach; Indonesian set lunch; Visit Kelingking Beach Secret Point; Swim or snorkel at Crystal Bay; Fast boat back to Bali; Transfer to hotel

Day 14**Bali Water Sports & Temple Views**

After breakfast, at 09:00, depart from your hotel to Tanjung Benoa Beach, the vibrant hub of Bali's marine adventures. Here, you'll enjoy an exciting Water Sport package that includes a round of Banana Boat riding and a glass-bottom boat ride to Turtle Island. On Turtle Island, you'll discover a dedicated turtle conservation area and observe these gentle creatures up close. Various other optional water sports, such as parasailing, jet skiing, flying fish, snorkeling, sea walking, and diving, are available for those wishing to extend their aquatic fun, at an additional cost.

Following your water activities, transfer to a local restaurant to savor a delicious Indonesian set lunch, recharging after your morning's excitement. The afternoon offers a choice of two captivating cultural excursions:

Option 1: Uluwatu Temple Tour Visit the majestic Uluwatu Temple, dramatically perched on a cliff over 100 meters above the Indian Ocean. From this vantage point, admire sweeping views of the turquoise sea and crashing waves. Wander the temple grounds, home to playful monkeys believed to guard this sacred site. If weather permits, witness a breathtaking sunset over the horizon, making this one of Bali's most unforgettable viewpoints.

Option 2: Tanah Lot Temple Tour Alternatively, visit Tanah Lot Temple, Bali's iconic sea temple, dramatically set on a rocky outcrop surrounded by ocean tides. The temple offers picture-perfect views, especially at sunset, when its silhouette glows against the golden sky. Around the temple, explore stalls selling Balinese handicrafts and souvenirs, ideal for gifts or personal collections.

Activities: Travel to Tanjung Benoa Beach; Enjoy Banana Boat ride; Take glass-bottom boat to Turtle Island; Lunch at local restaurant; Choose between Uluwatu Temple tour (with sunset) or Tanah Lot Temple tour (with sunset and shopping)
