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Day 2**Hanoi Cycling Tour & Historic Landmarks***Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Hanoi*

Following a brief orientation and essential safety guidelines, you'll savor a traditional egg coffee before setting off. The ride starts with a visit to the historic Long Bien Bridge, a century-old structure offering insights into Hanoi's past. From there, you'll cycle to Banana Island, also known as The Jungle, a green oasis providing a glimpse into nature and the lives of some of Hanoi's less fortunate residents.

The journey continues around the tranquil Hoan Kiem Lake, a peaceful contrast to the city's energy. You'll then proceed to St. Joseph's Church, an architectural gem in the French Quarter, before cycling past other notable landmarks such as Ba Dinh Square, the Presidential Palace, and the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum. Please note that these attractions will be observed from the outside. After an active morning of cycling and sightseeing, a delicious Vietnamese lunch awaits, offering a chance to taste local flavors. Finally, a driver will transfer you back to your hotel, concluding a fascinating exploration of Hanoi's beauty.

You'll then embark on a scenic 120 km bus journey through Vietnam's lush green landscapes towards Ninh Binh. A short comfort stop along the way allows for stretching and relaxation before arriving at Hoa Lu by approximately 10:30. In Hoa Lu, Vietnam's ancient capital, you will visit the historic King Dinh and Le Temples, structures dating back to the 11th century. At midday, a delightful buffet lunch featuring the rich flavors of Vietnamese cuisine will be served at a local restaurant.
