Bangkok's Sacred Sites & Canal Life

Your day begins with a breakfast featuring both Thai and Western options, preparing you for an extensive exploration of Bangkok's most revered temples. The first stop is Wat Traimit, home to an impressive solid gold Buddha statue. Continue through the historic heart of the city to Wat Pho, where you will admire the colossal reclining Buddha.

The journey then leads to the Grand Palace, a magnificent example of Thai Buddhist architecture. Within its expansive grounds, you'll discover glittering structures and beautiful gardens, including Wat Phra Kaew, which houses the revered Emerald Buddha from the 14th century. Following a delightful lunch at a local restaurant, you will embark on a classic 'longtail' boat trip.

This afternoon excursion takes you through the charming canals of Thonburi, offering a glimpse into a quieter, traditional way of life along the riverbanks. The canal tour culminates with a visit to the iconic Wat Arun, the Temple of Dawn, whose spectacular 79-meter pagoda stands majestically overlooking the Chao Phraya River. After disembarking, a car will transport you back to your hotel, allowing you to relax or venture out to experience Bangkok's lively evening atmosphere.

Day 3

Bangkok Exploration Day

Today is dedicated to personal exploration of Bangkok, giving you the freedom to discover the city at your leisure. For those seeking further adventure, optional tours are available (at an additional cost). Consider a Bangkok Street Food Tour by Tuk Tuk to sample local delicacies, a half-day trip to the famous Damnoen Saduak Floating Market for a unique cultural experience, or a full-day excursion to the historic River Kwai and Hell Fire Pass. This evening presents an ideal opportunity to create lasting memories on your final night in Bangkok.

Day 4**Journey to Chiang Mai & Northern City Tour***Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Chiang Mai | Transport: Car, Airplane*

Following breakfast, a private transfer will take you from your Bangkok hotel to the airport for a flight to Chiang Mai. After approximately an hour in the air, you will arrive at Chiang Mai International Airport, where your tour guide will meet you and facilitate your transfer to the hotel for check-in.

Your half-day city tour commences with a visit to Wat Phrathat Doi Suthep, considered one of Thailand's most sacred temples, perched high above the city. After descending the mountain, your next destination is Wat Chedi Luang, an impressive Lanna-style chedi that once stood as one of ancient Chiang Mai's tallest structures. Continue to Wat Phra Singh, also known as the Temple of the Lion Buddha, to admire its collection of classic Lanna art and explore an ancient library.

The tour also includes a stroll through the serene gardens of Wat Suan Dok, the Flower Garden Temple, where you can view a 500-year-old bronze Buddha statue, one of the largest in Thailand. The afternoon is then free for you to pursue your own interests, whether it's further exploration or relaxation.

Day 5**Chiang Mai Elephant Jungle Sanctuary Experience***Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Chiang Mai | Transport: Car*

Your day begins with a hotel pick-up in Chiang Mai between 08:00 and 08:30. A scenic 1.5-hour drive south of the city will take you through rolling hills, lush forests, and tranquil farming villages, leading to the Elephant Jungle Sanctuary. Upon arrival, you'll meet your guide and enjoy a short 10-15 minute trek through the jungle to reach the main sanctuary area.

Once at the sanctuary, you'll change into traditional Karen clothing and participate in an informative session about elephant anatomy, behavior, and history. This is followed by an opportunity to meet the elephants up close, feeding them, interacting, and observing them in their natural habitat while capturing memorable photographs. A delicious lunch featuring authentic Thai cuisine and fresh seasonal fruits will be served.

In the afternoon, engage in a hands-on session to prepare herbal medicine balls, which you will then feed to the elephants. Enjoy a walk with these gentle giants to a nearby river, where you can join them for a refreshing bath. Conclude your interactive experience with a fun and therapeutic mud spa session alongside the elephants, followed by another swim in the river. After changing into dry clothes and bidding farewell, you'll embark on the 1.5-hour drive back to Chiang Mai, arriving at

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your hotel between 17:00 and 17:30, with the evening free to reflect on your day.

Day 6**Chiang Mai to Hanoi & Old Quarter Food Tour**

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner | Stay: Hotel in Hanoi | Transport: Car, Airplane, Walking

After breakfast, you will be transferred from your hotel to Chiang Mai Airport for your flight to Hanoi, Vietnam's capital. Upon arrival at Hanoi Airport, your local tour guide will greet you and provide a comfortable transfer to your hotel for check-in. Please note that the standard check-in time for hotels in Hanoi is 14:00; early check-in may be arranged for an additional fee.

In the evening, around 17:30, your local guide will meet you at Shinhan Bank on Le Thai To Street. From this central point, you will embark on an immersive culinary walking tour through the historic and energetic Hanoi Old Quarter. This district is renowned for its diverse and beloved local dishes, offering a true taste of Vietnamese street food culture.

As you navigate the bustling alleyways and lantern-lit streets, you'll have the opportunity to sample a variety of authentic dishes. Typical tastings may include the fragrant Pho Bo (Vietnamese beef noodle soup), the delicate Bun Thang (rice vermicelli with shredded chicken and egg), the spicy Bun Bo Hue (Central Vietnamese noodle soup), and the iconic Banh Mi sandwich. You might also try Nom Bo Kho (green papaya salad with dried beef) and Nem Chua Ran (deep-fried fermented pork rolls). The tour concludes with a traditional Ca Phe Trung (Egg Coffee), a unique Hanoi specialty, before you return to your hotel.

Day 7**Hanoi to Halong Bay Overnight Cruise**

Following breakfast, you will depart from Hanoi for a scenic 2.5 to 3-hour drive to Halong Bay, a UNESCO World Heritage Site celebrated for its emerald waters and dramatic limestone karsts. Upon reaching the pier around midday, you will board your chosen cruise and receive a warm welcome from the crew. After settling into your cabin, a freshly prepared lunch will be served as the cruise begins its journey, gracefully navigating past stunning limestone islets and secluded coves.

The afternoon is filled with engaging activities designed to showcase the bay's natural beauty. You may visit a majestic limestone cave, explore a charming floating fishing village, or participate in kayaking or swimming in the serene waters.

Alternatively, you can simply relax on the sundeck, taking in the panoramic views of this extraordinary landscape.

As evening approaches, return to the cruise to witness a beautiful sunset, followed by a delicious Vietnamese dinner served onboard. The rest of the evening is at your leisure; you might join a cooking demonstration, try your hand at squid fishing, or simply unwind under the starlit sky. You will spend the night aboard the cruise in Halong Bay, surrounded by its tranquil beauty.

You are expected to arrive back in Hanoi by late afternoon, with the remainder of the evening free for you to relax at your hotel or explore the city at your own pace.

Day 9**Hanoi City Tour: History & Heritage***Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Hanoi | Transport: Car*

Gather in your hotel lobby at the scheduled time to meet your tour guide, who will provide an introduction before commencing a day of exploration in Vietnam's capital. Your cultural journey begins with a visit to the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, the revered resting place of Vietnam's iconic leader. These sites offer profound insights into Ho Chi Minh's life and enduring legacy. Next, admire the unique architectural beauty of the One Pillar Pagoda, a distinctive wooden structure built atop a single stone pillar. Rich in historical and spiritual symbolism, this iconic pagoda showcases centuries of Vietnamese artistry through its intricate design. The tour then proceeds to the Temple of Literature, recognized as Vietnam's First University. Originally established during the Ly Dynasty, this Confucian sanctuary is dedicated to scholars and sages. Wander through its ancient courtyards and pavilions, capturing memorable photos in this peaceful and historically significant setting, a testament to Hanoi's intellectual and cultural heritage.

Following the tour, relax and enjoy a flavorful meal at a local restaurant, featuring authentic Vietnamese cuisine, providing a perfect conclusion to your day of discovering the capital's timeless charm.

Day 10**Ninh Binh: Hoa Lu, Tam Coc & Hang Mua Exploration***Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Hanoi | Transport: Car, Boat, Walking*

After breakfast, depart from Hanoi for a scenic drive to Ninh Binh Province, often referred to as "the Halong Bay on land" due to its spectacular limestone landscapes. Your first destination is Hoa Lu, the ancient capital of Vietnam during the Dinh and early Le Dynasties in the 10th century. Here, you will visit the historic temples dedicated to King Dinh Tien Hoang and King Le Dai Hanh, gaining insights into the rich royal heritage and political importance of this former capital nestled amidst dramatic karst hills. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, savoring regional specialties.

In the afternoon, continue to Tam Coc, where you will board a traditional sampan boat for a serene journey along the Ngo Dong River. As you glide through lush rice paddies and beneath towering limestone cliffs and natural cave passages, you will be immersed in some of Vietnam's most picturesque countryside views. This tranquil experience offers a unique perspective of the landscape.

The final stop is Hang Mua (Mua Cave). Challenge yourself by climbing over 400 stone steps to the mountaintop. From the

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summit, you will be rewarded with breathtaking panoramic views of the entire Tam Coc Valley, the winding river, and endless rice fields, making it one of the best photographic spots in Ninh Binh. After a full day of exploration, you will return to Hanoi in the late afternoon.

Day 11**Hanoi to Hue: Imperial City Arrival***Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Hue | Transport: Car, Airplane*

Enjoy a relaxed morning in Hanoi. Depending on your flight schedule, you might have some free time for last-minute souvenir shopping or a leisurely walk through the charming Old Quarter. Your driver will then provide a comfortable transfer to the airport for your domestic flight to Hue, the former imperial capital of Vietnam.

Upon your arrival in Hue, you will be warmly greeted by your local guide and transferred directly to your hotel for check-in. The rest of the day is yours to unwind and acclimate to the serene atmosphere of Hue. Take the opportunity to explore the peaceful surroundings of your accommodation or simply relax after your journey, anticipating the historical discoveries of the coming days.

Day 12**Hue Imperial City & Pagoda Tour***Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Hue | Transport: Car*

Conclude your morning with a visit to Dong Ba Market, Hue's largest commercial center. Once in Hoi An, you will proceed to your hotel for check-in. The remainder of the day is free for you to settle in, relax, and perhaps take a preliminary stroll through the atmospheric streets of Hoi An at your leisure, preparing

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for a deeper exploration tomorrow.

Day 14

Hoi An Ancient Town Exploration

Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Hoi An | Transport: Walking

Your time in Hoi An includes a comprehensive visit to its most significant sites. Begin at Hoi An Market, a bustling hub where locals gather for fresh produce, snacks, and daily necessities. This offers a genuine insight into the daily life and culinary traditions of the town. Next, explore the Phuc Kien Chinese Assembly Hall, a vital religious site where residents pray for prosperity and safe travels, remaining an active center for community ceremonies.

Continue to the Phung Hung Ancient House and Tan Ky Ancient House, both meticulously preserved to showcase the lifestyle of merchant families during Hoi An's trading peak. These homes retain their original interiors and family collections, reflecting the town's rich commercial history. Another highlight is the Museum of Folk Culture, featuring straightforward exhibits on traditional crafts, farming tools, and items related to daily life in the old town.

Nearby, the Hoi An Traditional Performing Arts House offers brief shows introducing visitors to local music and folk performances. The itinerary also features the iconic Japanese Covered Bridge, a well-known landmark symbolizing Hoi An's multicultural connections throughout history. To conclude your visit, you'll have time to browse handicraft shops and art galleries, and wander through smaller lanes where daily activities continue to follow long-standing routines.

Day 15

Hoi An to Ho Chi Minh City & Southern City Tour

Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Ho Chi Minh | Transport: Car, Airplane

After a refreshing breakfast, you will check out from your hotel in Hoi An. Your driver will then transfer you to Da Nang Airport to catch your flight to Ho Chi Minh City, the bustling metropolis of southern Vietnam. Upon arrival at Tan Son Nhat Airport, a transfer will take you to your hotel for check-in and a brief period of refreshment before your afternoon city sightseeing begins. In the afternoon, your guide will meet you in the lobby to commence a tour of Ho Chi Minh City's historical landmarks. The first stop is the Reunification Palace, formerly the official residence of the President of the Republic of Vietnam, showcasing impressive French colonial architecture. Next, visit the War Remnants Museum, the city's oldest museum, housing poignant artifacts that recount the brutality of the Vietnam War.

Continue to the Saigon Central Post Office and Notre Dame Cathedral, both renowned for their iconic French colonial architecture (note: Notre Dame Cathedral is under renovation until 2027). Find a moment of peace at the Jade Emperor Pagoda, a historic Chinese temple adorned with brightly colored decorative designs. Conclude your tour by exploring a local market, where you can practice your bargaining skills while shopping for souvenirs. You will return to your hotel around 12:30, bidding farewell to your guide after an exciting morning.

Day 16

Mekong Delta River Life Exploration

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Ho Chi Minh | Transport: Car, Boat, Xe Loi (motorized rickshaw)

Following the river cruise, you will visit a coconut processing workshop, gaining insight into this important local industry. Afterward, enjoy tasty fresh fruit and tea at a traditional mat-weaving house. The journey continues with an experience on a "xe loi," a motorized rickshaw, which will take you through vibrant fruit orchards and agricultural landscapes, providing a close-up view of the region's produce. A specialty meal will be served for lunch at a charming riverside restaurant.

In the afternoon, prepare your camera for the next adventure: a sampan boat trip to explore the narrow canals. You will spend 10-15 minutes sailing through magnificent mangroves, experiencing the tranquil beauty of the delta's smaller waterways.

Around 17:00, you will be transferred back to your hotel in Ho Chi Minh City for relaxation after a day filled with unique cultural experiences.

Day 17**Ho Chi Minh City to Siem Reap Transfer**

Next, you will head to the antique capital of Angkor Thom, entering through its impressive South Gate, adorned with giant statues depicting the churning of the ocean of milk. Within Angkor Thom, explore the Bayon Temple, famous for its 54 towers intricately decorated with over 200 smiling faces of Avalokitesvara. You will also see the Phimeanakas, the Royal Enclosure, the Elephants Terrace, and the Terrace of the Leper King. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, savoring Cambodian cuisine.

In the afternoon, you will contemplate the World Heritage Site of Angkor Wat, the most famous temple on the plain of Angkor. Learn about authentic ancient Khmer architecture as you explore its five towers, symbolizing Meru's five peaks, its enclosed wall representing the mountains at the edge of the world, and the surrounding moat, the ocean beyond. Conclude your day by ascending Phnom Bakheng mountain to witness a charming sunset as the sun descends over the ancient temples. Afterward, return to your hotel for refreshments.

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Day 19**Siem Reap Departure***Meals: Breakfast | Stay: NA | Transport: Car*
