Bangkok Arrival & Chao Phraya River Cruise

Here, you can admire its distinctive Buddhist architecture, particularly enchanting as the sun begins to set, casting a golden glow over the temple spires. After this picturesque experience, you will return to your hotel, with the evening free to explore Bangkok's lively nightlife at your leisure.

Day 2

Bangkok Royal Grandeur & Silk Heritage

Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Bangkok | Transport: Car

Begin your day with breakfast before heading to the Grand Royal Palace, a significant landmark and former residence of the Thai Royal family. Within this expansive complex, you will encounter the breathtaking Wat Phra Kaew, home to the revered Emerald Buddha. The intricate designs and spiritual significance of this temple offer profound insights into Thai culture and artistry.

Following your visit to the Grand Palace, the journey continues to Wat Pho, where the colossal reclining Buddha statue awaits.

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This impressive monument is a highlight, showcasing remarkable craftsmanship. After some personal time for lunch, the afternoon takes you to the Jim Thompson House. This traditional Thai teak house museum tells the story of an American businessman who significantly influenced the global Thai silk industry.

Discover the unique architecture and fascinating history of Jim Thompson's life in Thailand, including his contributions to Thai silk. Conclude your day with a transfer back to your hotel, leaving the remainder of the evening open for your own exploration.

Day 3

Ancient Ayutthaya Exploration

Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Bangkok | Transport: Car

After breakfast at your hotel, embark on a journey back in time to the ancient city of Ayutthaya. Your first stop outside the old city walls is Wat Phu Khao Thong, known as the 'Monastery of the Golden Mount.' This site offers a glimpse into the region's historical and religious landscape.

Proceed into the heart of Ayutthaya to explore the remnants of a once-mighty dynasty. A key site is Wat Phra Si Sanphet, featuring three Sri Lankan-style chedis that once housed the ashes of three Ayutthayan kings: Ramathibodi II, Borom Trailokkanat, and Borom Rachathirat III. Next, visit Viharn Phra Mongkol Bopit, which shelters a large, gilded Buddha image, one of the few to survive the Burmese invasion in the late 18th century. Enjoy lunch at your leisure to refuel.

The afternoon highlights include the colossal reclining Buddha at Wat Lokaya Sutha, where locals traditionally place gold leaf for blessings. Conclude your Ayutthaya exploration at the Bang Pa-In Summer Palace, a favored royal retreat renowned for its eclectic mix of European, Khmer, Thai, and Chinese architectural styles. As the day ends, return to your Bangkok hotel for relaxation.

Activities: Visit Wat Phu Khao Thong (Monastery of the Golden Mount).
Explore the ruins of Wat Phra Si Sanphet.
See the gilded Buddha image at Viharn Phra Mongkol Bopit.

Day 4

Following breakfast, you will check out from your Bangkok hotel. A private transfer will take you to the airport for your flight to Siem Reap, Cambodia. This flight marks your transition from the vibrant energy of Thailand to the historical grandeur of Cambodia.

Upon landing at Siem Reap airport, a local guide and driver will greet you. They will assist with your transfer to the hotel for check-in. The rest of the day is dedicated to relaxation and personal leisure. You have the opportunity to unwind after your

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travel, settle into your new surroundings, or perhaps take a preliminary stroll to familiarize yourself with the charming town of Siem Reap.

Day 5**Angkor Wat & Angkor Thom Grand Tour**

Your guide will lead you first to Angkor Thom, the last great capital city, entering through its impressive South Gate. Here, you will marvel at the intricate sandstone constructions, including statues of deities and demons clutching nagas. Within Angkor Thom, discover the iconic Bayon Temple, distinguished by its 54 towers adorned with over 200 serene smiling faces of Avalokiteshvara. The tour continues to other significant structures such as Phimeanakas, the Royal Enclosure, the Elephants Terrace, and the Terrace of the Leper King. A highlight of the morning is the mysterious Ta Prohm Temple, famously known as the 'Tomb Raider' temple, where ancient stone structures are intertwined with giant fig trees and sprawling vines, creating a truly unique photographic opportunity. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant, offering a taste of Cambodian cuisine.

The afternoon is reserved for the magnificent Angkor Wat, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the most celebrated temple in the Angkor Plain. Your guide will illuminate the authentic ancient Khmer architecture, explaining how its five towers symbolize the peaks of Mount Meru, the surrounding wall represents the mountains at the world's edge, and the moat signifies the distant ocean. As the sun begins its descent and your day of exploration concludes, you will return to town.

Following breakfast, join your guide for a drive to Kompong Khleang, one of the largest and less-frequented floating villages on Tonle Sap Lake. This excursion offers a genuine insight into the local fishing industry and the unique way of life adapted to the lake's seasonal water levels.

Depending on the season, you will either cruise along canals or navigate streets, observing the stilted houses that appear to float on the water during the wet season. The journey includes a visit to a local pagoda, built on an ancient temple site, where

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you can admire wall paintings and capture memorable photographs. A stop at a village home provides an opportunity to learn more about the residents' daily routines and the ingenious natural flood barriers protecting their community.

This immersive experience allows you to witness the exotic floating houses and the incredible natural environment of Tonle Sap Lake. After disembarking, you will be driven back to your hotel in Siem Reap to relax and unwind.

Meals: Breakfast, Dinner | Stay: Hotel in Ho Chi Minh | Transport: Car, Airplane, Cruise

Bid farewell to Cambodia this morning. After breakfast and checking out from your Siem Reap hotel, you will be transferred to the airport for your flight to Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam, often referred to as Saigon. Upon your arrival at Tan Son Nhat Airport, a local guide and driver will provide a warm welcome and take you to your hotel for check-in.

The afternoon is free for you to refresh and settle in after your flight. As evening approaches, prepare for a delightful culinary experience. Between 6:00 PM and 6:30 PM, your driver will pick you up for a transfer to the port, where you will board a cruise for dinner on the Saigon River.

Day 9

Explore the jungle environment to discover cleverly hidden traps, secret entrances, bunkers, and underground hideouts. You will have the opportunity to venture into a section of the extensive tunnel network, experiencing the cramped conditions where soldiers lived and worked. For those interested, there is a chance to try a shooting rifle at an optional range. Conclude your Cu Chi experience with a taste of specialty cassava and local green tea. Return to the city center for lunch, sampling regional cuisine.

The afternoon continues with a tour of Ho Chi Minh City's most prominent landmarks. Visit the Reunification Palace, a site rich in modern Vietnamese history. Capture photos in its airy square and admire the French colonial architecture. Next, see the Old Post Office and Notre Dame Cathedral (currently under renovation, viewable from outside), appreciating their architectural grandeur. The War Remnants Museum offers a poignant look at the Vietnam War through realistic artifacts. Conclude your day with a stroll through Ben Thanh Market, observing local commerce and perhaps practicing your bargaining skills for souvenirs. The tour ends back at your hotel.

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check-in and a chance to refresh.

As evening approaches, prepare for a delightful culinary adventure. Around 5:30 PM, a local guide will meet you at Shinhan Bank (14 Le Thai To Street) to begin a guided night walk and street food tour through Hanoi's bustling Old Quarter. This immersive experience allows you to sample a diverse array of local delicacies.

Potential dishes include soup-based favorites like Pho Bo (Vietnamese Beef Noodles), Bun Thang (Rice Vermicelli Noodles with Chicken and Eggs), or Bun Bo Hue. You might also try quick servings such as Banh Cuon (Steamed Rice Rolls) and Banh Mi (Vietnamese bread). Street snacks like Nom Bo Kho (Dried Beef Salad) and Nem Chua Ran (Fried Fermented Pork Roll) are also on the menu. The tour concludes with a taste of the famous Ca Phe Trung, or Egg Coffee, a unique Hanoi specialty.

Begin your journey at the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first national university, which has long been a center of Confucianism and a birthplace of Vietnamese intellectual talent. Next, visit Ba Dinh Square, where Ho Chi Minh declared Vietnam's independence, and see the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (exterior viewing, as it closes on Mondays, Fridays, and for renovations from June to August). Nearby, admire the unique architecture of the One Pillar Pagoda, an important Buddhist structure.

Conclude your morning with a stroll along the picturesque Thanh Nien Street, leading to Tran Quoc Pagoda. Located on an island in West Lake, this pagoda offers beautiful views, especially as the sun begins to set (though your visit will be in the morning). Enjoy an authentic Hanoi lunch before returning to your hotel for an afternoon of leisure, allowing you to explore Hanoi's evening ambiance independently.

Activities: Visit the Temple of Literature.
Explore Ba Dinh Square and view Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (exterior).
Contemplate the unique One Pillar Pagoda.
Stroll along Thanh Nien Street.
Visit Tran Quoc Pagoda on West Lake.

Day 12

Ninh Binh's Bai Dinh Pagoda & Trang An Grottoes

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Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Hanoi | Transport: Car, Electric vehicle, Rowed boat

Following breakfast at 8:00 AM, your guide will accompany you on a two-hour drive to Ninh Binh province, a region celebrated for its stunning natural beauty. Your first destination is the Bai Dinh Complex, Southeast Asia's largest Buddhist pagoda. An electric vehicle will transport you through the vast complex, where you can marvel at 500 Arhat statues carved from stone, a bell tower housing bronze bells weighing 27 and 36 tons, and a golden Goddess of Mercy statue.

Hike to the mountain's summit for breathtaking panoramic views and to learn about engaging Buddhist narratives. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant, offering a chance to sample diverse regional cuisine.

In the afternoon, embark on a serene rowed boat trip through the Trang An cave network. Glide through crystal-clear waters, surrounded by crisp air and dramatic limestone karst mountains, experiencing a profound sense of tranquility. As the day concludes, you will make your way back to Hanoi, arriving at your hotel around 6:00 PM.

After breakfast, a luxury limousine will pick you up from your hotel between 8:00 AM and 8:30 AM for a 2.5-hour transfer to Halong Bay, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, with a brief stop halfway. Upon arrival at the cruise waiting lounge, you will be warmly greeted by staff and complete check-in procedures.

A speed boat will then take you to your main cruise vessel, where the cruise manager will share intriguing stories about the bay. Boarding commences around 12:15 PM, followed by a welcome drink, a safety briefing, and check-in to your cabin. A delicious lunch awaits you in the restaurant, served as the cruise begins its scenic journey through thousands of limestone formations rising from the clear green waters.

The afternoon is dedicated to engaging water activities, bringing you closer to the bay's natural splendor. Depending on your cruise itinerary, you may explore caves, climb to an island's summit for panoramic views, or enjoy kayaking in the serene waters. Return to the cruise for a cooking class with a Vietnamese chef or relax during Happy Hour (5:00 PM - 5:30 PM) while admiring the enchanting sunset. A fancy dinner is served in the evening, followed by vibrant nighttime activities such as squid fishing, watching movies, playing board games, or visiting the onboard bar.
