Continue your cultural journey to The Grand Palace, a pivotal landmark in Thailand. Here, you will be captivated by the architectural splendor of its buildings and throne halls. Witness the revered Emerald Buddha, a highly significant religious icon in Thailand. A delightful Thai lunch will be served at the Never Ending Summer restaurant, offering a rustic ambiance by the Chao Phraya River. Please note that lunch includes a choice of one main dish and drinking water.

In the afternoon, board a traditional long-tail boat for a scenic ride along the majestic Chao Phraya River. The boat will then venture into a network of Khlongs, or canals, guiding you away from typical tourist routes. Along these waterways, you will visit

Wat Khun Chan, an intriguing temple rarely frequented by visitors. Cross a small footbridge to explore old alleys, perhaps enjoying a refreshing coffee, before reaching Wat Paknam, known for its distinctive white stupa and hidden museum. The boat journey continues through a picturesque section of the Khlongs, showcasing a mix of traditional wooden houses and contemporary mansions, culminating in a visit to an orchid and fruit farm where you can observe various orchid species. Finally, you will be transferred back to your hotel, concluding the day's excursions.

Here, you'll have the opportunity to observe vendors swiftly retracting their stalls as a train passes directly through the market, a truly remarkable sight. Take photos and sample local snacks before continuing your journey to Damnoen Saduak. At Damnoen Saduak, experience the charm of a rural floating market. Board a motorboat for a ride along the waterways, navigating through the picturesque market where goods are sold directly from boats. After exploring the market, the road trip continues towards the city of Kanchanaburi. Upon arrival in Kanchanaburi, delve into World War II history with visits to the Jeath War Museum and the War Cemetery, poignant memorials to the conflict. Conclude your historical exploration by boarding a train for a scenic 30-minute ride along the river, followed by a visit to the iconic Bridge over the River Kwai. You will then check into your hotel for the night in Kanchanaburi.

for a refreshing walk up the trails to discover the various levels of these picturesque falls. Remember to bring comfortable walking shoes, and if you wish to swim in the natural pools, a swimsuit is recommended.

Following your waterfall adventure, you will continue your journey by road to Ayutthaya. This drive covers approximately 220 kilometers and takes about 3.5 hours. The ancient city of Ayutthaya, often referred to as the 'Venice of the East' due to its location along the Chao Phraya River and its surrounding tributaries, holds significant historical importance. Founded in 1350 by King Uthong, it served as the capital when the Thai people migrated south. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and enjoy some free time at your leisure.

Your ride will take you to several prominent temples, starting with Wat Yai Chaimongkol. Next, visit Wat Mahathat, famous for the Buddha head intertwined within the roots of a tree. Enjoy a stroll through a local market en route to Wat Phra Srisanphet.

Following your temple explorations, the tour proceeds to the Bang Pa-In Summer Palace. This royal residence, dating back to the Ayutthaya era, showcases an intriguing blend of European, Khmer, Thai, and Chinese architectural styles, reflecting its history as a favored retreat for the King. After the palace visit, you will be transferred back to Bangkok to catch your flight to Chiang Rai.

Upon arrival at Chiang Rai, a local guide will meet you and provide a transfer to your hotel. The evening is free for you to relax and settle into your new surroundings.

After breakfast, your guide will lead you to a local market, offering an authentic glimpse into daily life and an opportunity to discover regional products. Following the market visit, you will explore the renowned Wat Phra Kaew, a temple historically significant as the former home of the Emerald Buddha image.

Continue to Wat Phra Singh, which enshrines one of Thailand's most beautiful Buddha images. A short drive from Chiang Rai city takes you to Baan Dam, also known as the Black House. This unique complex is the creation of national artist Thawan Duchanee, serving as an art studio, museum, and home, featuring an eclectic mix of traditional northern Thai structures and striking modern designs. Lunch will be at your own expense, allowing you flexibility.

In the afternoon, embark on a boat cruise along the Mae Kok River from Chiang Rai to a Karen village. Here, you can observe or feed elephants. Afterwards, enjoy a one-hour elephant trekking experience. Conclude your day with a transfer back to Chiang Rai for your overnight stay.

In the afternoon, embark on a scenic road trip to Chiang Mai, often referred to as the 'Capital of the North.' En route, you will pause for a fascinating walk through the intricate maze of underground galleries in Chiang Dao. Afterwards, take a walk through the central Warorot Market, a bustling hub of local commerce. After lunch, you will be transferred to your hotel for check-in. In the afternoon, a visit to Doi Suthep hill is a highlight. This mountain temple is among Thailand's most historically and spiritually significant sites. You will drive up scenic mountainous terrains, passing lush landscapes to reach the base of the temple complex. Ascend over 300 steps or take an elevator to the summit, where you can admire picturesque panoramic views of Chiang Mai City. The evening offers an opportunity to browse the vibrant Night Market. The afternoon features a two-hour boat trip along the tranquil Mae Ping River. This leisurely cruise offers an excellent way to spend your afternoon, allowing you to observe the changing scenery along the riverbanks. You will pass many beautiful traditional teak houses and lush rural greenery. After the river cruise, you will be transferred back to your hotel, with the rest of the day at your leisure.
