Enjoy traditional folk music performed by local hosts before boarding a small rowing boat to navigate the island's narrow canals. A relaxed cooking session and lunch await at a local ecolodge. Continue to Quang Phu Cau Incense Village, where you can wander through vibrant lanes filled with drying incense sticks and learn about their cultural significance. The day concludes with a visit to a To He village, where you can try shaping small figures from colored rice dough, a delightful hands-on activity suitable for all ages.

Option 2: Alternatively, travel to Bat Trang Ceramic Village, famous for its ancient pottery traditions. Witness skilled craftsmen at work and even try your hand at creating your own ceramic piece. Next, visit Ha Thai Lacquer Village to see the detailed process of lacquerware creation, from initial stages to the finished product, with an opportunity to try a simple painting activity.
