After breakfast, your guide will pick you up from your hotel for a journey of approximately 55 kilometers from Siem Reap to Kompong Khleang, one of the largest and less-visited floating communities on Tonle Sap Lake. The exploration of the village varies with the season: in the dry season, you will tour the town's streets, observing life in the stilt houses; in the wet season, you will navigate through waterways where homes appear to float above the water.

You will examine the wall murals in one of the pagodas, built on the site of an ancient temple, and then stop at a local household to gain insights into rural daily life. Afterward, board a boat to travel into the open waters of Tonle Sap Lake, observing a smaller floating community and learning about the lake's crucial role as a natural flood system supporting local livelihoods. You will return to Siem Reap in the afternoon, with the rest of the day at your leisure.
