Your visit includes Preah Ang Check and Preah Ang Chorm Shrine, where locals offer prayers for good fortune, protection, and prosperity amidst fragrant incense and colorful offerings. The journey continues to the Satcha Handicraft Center, a dynamic creative hub where Cambodian artisans blend traditional techniques with contemporary design. You'll witness craftsmen at work, admire intricate carvings and textiles, and

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support a sustainable model that preserves cultural heritage while empowering local communities.

After lunch, return to Ho Chi Minh City for an afternoon dedicated to cultural highlights. Begin with two iconic examples of French colonial architecture: the Notre Dame Cathedral (currently undergoing renovation, an alternative visit will be provided) and the stately Old Post Office, admired for its arched ceilings and historical charm. Next, visit the Reunification Palace, the former presidential residence and the significant site of Vietnam's reunification in 1975. Its unique blend of modernist and Asian design makes it a compelling stop. Then, step into the War Remnants Museum, a poignant but important site that illustrates the impact of the Vietnam War through powerful photography and exhibits. Conclude your city adventure at the lively Ben Thanh Market, a Saigon landmark brimming with colorful stalls and local goods. It's an ideal place to find souvenirs, sample street food, or simply absorb the vibrant local atmosphere. You'll return to your hotel in the late afternoon, enriched with deeper insights into Vietnam's past and present.
