This remarkable structure is notable for its vibrant colors and distinctive blend of architectural styles, resembling a church but incorporating diverse religious symbols and imagery inside and out. Take time to observe its spiritual splendor and unique construction.

Following lunch, embark on a half-day excursion to the Cu Chi Tunnels, a significant relic from the Vietnam War. Here, you'll gain an understanding of how Vietcong soldiers lived and operated underground. Begin with a documentary explaining the tunnels' role in the war, then proceed to explore the site, which features weapon and booby trap exhibitions.

Navigate a section of the authentic tunnels, discovering various underground bunkers, including kitchens, meeting rooms, and ammunition storage. An optional shooting range offers the chance to try firing an AK-47 or M16 (at an additional cost).

Conclude the visit by tasting tapioca and hot tea, staple foods for soldiers during the conflict, before returning to Ho Chi Minh City for a relaxing evening.
