Day 3**Halong Bay Cruise & Onboard Activities***Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Stay: Halong Bay Cruise | Transport: Private transfer, Cruise boat*

After breakfast, between 8:00 AM and 8:30 AM, a vehicle will pick you up from your hotel in Hanoi's Old Quarter for a scenic transfer to Halong Bay via the modern Hanoi–Hai Phong Expressway. Upon arrival, you will board your chosen cruise ship. A welcome drink awaits as the crew provides a brief orientation and essential safety information. Lunch will be served in the onboard restaurant as the vessel commences its journey through Halong Bay's breathtaking limestone karsts and stunning seascapes.

The afternoon offers choices for relaxation or activity. You may opt to unwind on deck, or if desired, book an optional spa treatment (advance booking is recommended). Later, the cruise will visit an impressive cave within Halong Bay, allowing you to explore its fascinating rock formations. Returning to the ship, you can participate in engaging onboard activities such as a Vietnamese cooking demonstration or a fruit and vegetable carving session.

In the evening, savor a freshly prepared dinner onboard, surrounded by the tranquil beauty of the bay. After breakfast, you will meet your guide around 8:00 AM to begin a scenic bicycle ride towards Cam Thanh Village. This tranquil, verdant area is situated just outside Hoi An. Upon arrival, a local host will extend a warm welcome and introduce you to traditional rice farming practices. You will engage in hands-on activities such as plowing and raking the soil with the assistance of a water buffalo, transplanting rice seedlings, and learning about the traditional methods of processing rice. For a unique and enjoyable experience, you can even try riding a water buffalo.

The journey continues to a nearby fishing village, where local fishermen will demonstrate their daily routines. You will have the chance to try casting a fishing net, an interactive activity suitable for both children and adults. Next, prepare for a distinctive basket boat ride through the lush coconut forest, a highlight of the day's ecological exploration. The morning concludes with a

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home-cooked lunch at a local residence, offering an authentic taste of Vietnamese hospitality.

In the afternoon, you will return to your hotel, where you can enjoy a relaxing period at your leisure. This provides an opportunity to unwind and recharge after an active and memorable day filled with cultural and ecological discoveries.

Your ascent begins at Suoi Mo Cable Car Station, where you will board a scenic cable car, gliding over verdant mountains and forests towards Marseille Station. Upon reaching your destination, the iconic Golden Bridge awaits, renowned for its distinctive design appearing to be supported by colossal stone hands. Take time to absorb the panoramic views of the surrounding hills and capture memorable family photographs.

Proceed to Jardin D'Amour, a beautifully manicured garden featuring vibrant flowers, elegant fountains, and artistic sculptures, perfect for a leisurely walk. Next, visit Linh Ung Pagoda, home to an impressive statue of the Goddess of Mercy, offering a peaceful and spiritual ambiance. A buffet lunch will be served at a local restaurant, presenting a wide array of Vietnamese and international dishes suitable for all ages.

The afternoon is dedicated to Fantasy Park, an indoor amusement park filled with various rides, games, and entertainment options for both children and adults. Later, another cable car ride will take you up to King Peak, standing at an altitude of 1,487 meters, providing sweeping views of the landscape. You will then return via cable car and transfer back to your hotel in the late afternoon. Please note that the ticket includes round-trip cable car access and entry to attractions like the Golden Bridge, Fantasy Park, and Moon Castle, with some exclusions like the wax museum or wine cellar.

Following breakfast, you will embark on an exciting exploration of the Angkor complex aboard a traditional tuk-tuk (remork). Your journey begins at Angkor Thom, the final capital of the Khmer Empire. You will pass through its impressive gates before

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continuing to the remarkable Bayon Temple, famous for its iconic stone towers adorned with serene, smiling faces. Next, you will visit the Terrace of the Elephants and the Terrace of the Leper King, both featuring intricate carvings depicting ancient ceremonies and Khmer legends. You will also explore remnants of the former Royal Palace grounds.

The tour then proceeds to Ta Prohm, renowned for its atmospheric ruins intertwined with massive tree roots. Alternatively, you may visit Preah Khan for a quieter experience. You will return to Siem Reap for lunch at a local restaurant. In the afternoon, a private vehicle will take you into the countryside for a more local and authentic experience. Visit a local market to observe daily life, interact with residents, and learn a few basic Khmer phrases, an engaging activity for all ages.

Continue to Phnom Bok, where those who wish can climb approximately 635 steps to the summit for panoramic views of the surrounding countryside and a visit to a small temple. On the return journey, enjoy views of rural villages and rice fields before stopping at a local evening market or fairground, offering a relaxed and enjoyable atmosphere.

After an early pickup, you will travel approximately 25 minutes to Ta Brak Village for an authentic glimpse into rural Cambodian life. A packed Western-style breakfast, provided by your hotel, will be enjoyed while visiting a local family, offering a wonderful opportunity to learn about daily routines in the village. Continue with a traditional ox cart ride, lasting about 30 minutes, to a nearby local market where you can observe everyday trading and explore local produce.

Next, enjoy a short walk of about 0.6 miles (1 km) through picturesque countryside, passing rice paddies and sugar palm trees. Along the way, you may have the chance to interact with villagers and participate in seasonal activities such as rice planting, weaving, or crafting fish traps. The morning concludes at a local pagoda, where your family will receive a traditional water blessing from Buddhist monks, a meaningful cultural experience.

In the afternoon, visit Bakong Temple, a 9th-century temple and an important site of early Khmer civilization. Afterward, proceed to Tonle Sap Lake, Southeast Asia's largest freshwater lake and a UNESCO biosphere reserve. From here, take a boat trip to Kampong Phluk, a traditional floating village known for its stilt houses and flooded mangrove forest. Cruise through the waterways to observe daily life on the water, including floating homes and fishing communities, offering a unique and immersive perspective. Enjoy a home-hosted meal in one of the floating houses before returning to Siem Reap. Note that due to low water levels in the dry season, boat trips are only possible from June to March; an alternative floating village at Chong Kneas may be arranged outside these months.

Stroll through gardens abundant with tropical fruits like durian, longan, and jackfruit, enjoying the peaceful surroundings. Visit a local home to experience traditional folk music performed by regional artists, accompanied by fresh fruit and tea. Continue with a relaxing boat ride through narrow canals, offering a closer look at daily life along the waterways. You will arrive at Mekong Ecolodge, where you will participate in a cooking activity, followed by a delicious lunch featuring Mekong Delta specialties. In the afternoon, enjoy a leisurely walk around the ecolodge's gardens, filled with tropical fruits and flowers. This provides an excellent opportunity for families to relax and for children to explore nature. At approximately 1:00 PM, you will return by boat to

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Cai Be pier, then transfer back to Ho Chi Minh City, concluding a day of discovery in the delta.
