This portion of the trek offers a deeper connection to the local communities and the area's natural beauty.

After exploring Ta Van, you will be transferred back to Sapa by car. The remainder of the day is free for you to relax at your hotel, perhaps reflecting on the day's cultural encounters and scenic vistas. Enjoy an overnight stay in Sapa.

Continue to Phimeanakas, the Royal Enclosure, the Elephants Terrace, and the Terrace of the Leper King, each offering unique historical insights.

The afternoon, starting around 1:30 PM, is dedicated to exploring Angkor Wat, the most renowned of all the temples on the plain of Angkor. This architectural masterpiece is a testament to Khmer ingenuity and spiritual devotion.
