Day 1

Hanoi Arrival & Optional City Exploration

Other fascinating options include a night tour of the Hoa Lo Prison or an evening exploration of the Imperial Citadel of Thang Long. Your airport pickup point will be Pole No.10 outside the terminal gate, where your guide awaits. Standard hotel check-in time is 2:00 PM; early check-in may incur an additional fee.

Day 2

Hanoi's Cultural Landmarks & Historic Sites

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Hanoi

Begin your day with a guided exploration of Hanoi's most significant cultural and historical attractions. Your tour includes a visit to the Temple of Literature, a serene complex that served as Vietnam's first national university. Next, proceed to the unique One Pillar Pagoda, an iconic Buddhist temple set gracefully on a single stone pillar, resembling a lotus flower emerging from the water. You will also view the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum from the outside, the final resting place of Vietnam's revered leader (please note it is closed on Mondays, Fridays, and from June to August). Conclude your morning with a visit to Tran Quoc Pagoda, Hanoi's oldest Buddhist temple, boasting over 1500 years of history on an island in West Lake. Enjoy lunch at a local Vietnamese restaurant before having free time in the afternoon.

Activities: Visit the Temple of Literature.

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Explore the One Pillar Pagoda.
View the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum from outside.
Discover Tran Quoc Pagoda.
Enjoy lunch at a local Vietnamese restaurant.
Relax during free time in the afternoon.

Day 3**Halong Bay Cruise & Kayaking Adventure**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Stay: Overnight on cruise | Transport: Car, Cruise

After breakfast at your hotel, your tour guide will pick you up for a scenic transfer to Halong Bay, a UNESCO World Heritage Site renowned for its emerald waters and thousands of towering limestone islands. The journey to the cruise port typically takes about 2.5 hours. Upon arrival, complete the check-in procedures before boarding your chosen cruise vessel. You'll receive a warm welcome from the friendly crew with a refreshing drink. As you sail into the magnificent bay, a delicious lunch featuring fresh seafood will be served, allowing you to savor the stunning panoramic views. Your day begins at 8:00 AM with a trip to the Cu Chi Tunnels, located approximately 60 km north of Ho Chi Minh City. This extensive network of underground tunnels offers a profound insight into the Vietnamese War. You'll have the opportunity to explore parts of the tunnels, learning about the challenging conditions in which Vietnamese soldiers lived and fought during the conflict.

For an additional charge, you can experience a firing-gun service at the shooting range. After gaining a deeper understanding of this historical site, you'll enjoy a light lunch at a local restaurant before returning to Ho Chi Minh City. The afternoon tour, starting at 1:30 PM, includes a visit to the Reunification Palace, a significant symbol of Saigon's liberation. You'll also admire the colonial architecture of the Saigon Notre Dame Cathedral (currently under renovation) and the historic Old Post Office. Conclude your day with a stop at a local market, perfect for souvenir shopping and experiencing the warm hospitality of the local people.

Day 6**Mekong Delta Riverine Exploration**

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Ho Chi Minh | Transport: Car, Boat, Xe Loi, Sampan

At 8:00 AM, you will depart from your hotel for a full-day excursion to Ben Tre Province in the Mekong Delta. The journey offers picturesque views as you travel. Upon arrival, you'll embark on a boat trip along the Ham Luong River, observing the serene riverine landscape and stopping at various local workshops. Here, you can witness the traditional methods used by villagers to create local products, gaining insight into their daily lives and craftsmanship.

Take a leisurely stroll around the village, soaking in the peaceful and friendly atmosphere of the Mekong Delta. An authentic experience awaits as you travel to fruit orchards by 'Xe Loi', a unique motorized rickshaw, allowing you to explore the lush surroundings. In the afternoon, a sampan boat ride, expertly rowed by locals, will take you along narrow canals, offering a tranquil perspective of the Mekong's beautiful waterways. You will return to your hotel in Ho Chi Minh City around 5:00 PM, with the rest of the evening free for relaxation.
