Day 2

The morning begins with a visit to the Ho Chi Minh Complex, which includes the revered Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum, his tranquil Stilts House, the Presidential Palace, and the nearby One Pillar Pagoda. These sites offer profound insights into Vietnam's revolutionary leader and architectural heritage. Following this, you will explore the serene Lake of the Restored Sword and Ngoc Son Temple, central to Hanoi's folklore and spiritual life.

The tour continues to the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first national university, showcasing traditional Vietnamese architecture and scholarly traditions. Later, you'll experience the peaceful West Lake, known for its scenic views and the sedate

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Tran Quoc Pagoda. An hour-long cyclo tour through the bustling Old Quarter provides a unique perspective on Hanoi's vibrant street life and ancient trading roots. The day concludes with a traditional Water Puppet show, an art form deeply rooted in Vietnamese culture.

Day 3**Ninh Binh's Ancient Capital & Scenic Grottoes, Overnight Train to Lao Cai**

Stay: Overnight on train with A/C, soft sleeper cabin (4 people/cabin) | Transport: Private vehicle, boat, overnight train

Your day starts with a morning departure for Hoa Lu, a journey of approximately two hours by road. Hoa Lu served as Vietnam's capital from 968 AD to 1010 AD, leaving behind a legacy of two ancient temples dedicated to the Dinh and Le Rulers. After exploring these nearly thousand-year-old structures, you will ascend 200 steps to the summit of Ma Yen mount, offering a panoramic view of the surrounding landscape, characterized by dramatic limestone formations.

The next destination is Tam Coc, often referred to as

Day 4**Sapa Arrival & Cat Cat Village Trek**

The night train from Hanoi arrives at Lao Cai train station around 06:00 AM. Awaiting vehicle will then transfer you on a scenic 1.5-hour drive covering 33 km to the highland town of Sapa. Upon arrival, the morning is free for you to explore Sapa town at your leisure, perhaps visiting the local market or enjoying the crisp mountain air.

In the afternoon, an engaging walking tour leads to the hill tribe villages of Cat Cat. This area is home to the Black H'mong minority peoples. As you trek through the valley below Sapa, you will encounter local villagers going about their daily lives. This provides a valuable opportunity to engage with and understand the cultural experiences of the families residing in this picturesque region.

Today's adventure begins in the morning with a car transfer from your hotel, heading into the scenic valley. Here, you will visit two distinct villages inhabited by the H'mong and Dzay ethnic groups. This trek offers an intimate look into their traditional lifestyles and agricultural practices amidst stunning mountain scenery. A picnic lunch will be enjoyed either en route or with a local family, providing a taste of authentic local hospitality.

The journey continues with a visit to the Red Dzao people in Giang Ta Chai village. Along the way, you'll encounter a beautiful waterfall and cross a sturdy suspension bridge, adding to the picturesque experience. After approximately four hours of trekking over seven kilometers, you will walk back to the main road where a car will be waiting to transfer you back to Sapa for the evening.

An early morning departure takes you on a two-hour drive to Bac Ha, renowned for its vibrant Sunday market. This is the largest and most colorful market in the region, where various ethnic groups, including the Flower Hmong, Phu La, Black Dao, Tay, and Nung minorities, gather to trade unique local products. The market offers a fascinating glimpse into the diverse cultures and traditional commerce of the northern highlands.

After enjoying lunch, the tour includes a walk to Trung Do, a village inhabited by the Tay minority. Here, you will board a traditional boat for a leisurely cruise along the Chay River, soaking in the serene riverine landscapes. Following the cruise, you will transfer back to Lao Cai to catch the night train, returning to Hanoi for an overnight journey.
