The tour culminates with a tranquil excursion into the verdant Mekong Delta, offering a glimpse into rural riverine existence.

Day 2

Hanoi Cultural Landmarks and Old Quarter Exploration

Meals: B,L | Stay: Peridot Grand Luxury hotel | Transport: Private car

Today features an enriching city excursion to some of Hanoi's most significant cultural sites. Begin with a visit to the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first national university, a serene complex of courtyards and pavilions. Afterwards, explore the tranquil West Lake area, observing the scenic Thanh Nien street and the ancient Tran Quoc Pagoda, an important Buddhist shrine. Later, your guide will lead a fascinating walking tour through the historic Old Quarter. This maze of narrow streets is famous for its '36 Streets,' traditionally named after the goods once sold there. You'll pass by streets that still honor their namesake trades, such as Tin and Bamboo Street, offering a glimpse into Hanoi's commercial past. The guided walk concludes with a refreshing Vietnamese coffee at a cafe that provides picturesque views of Hoan Kiem Lake, a central symbol in Vietnamese folklore.

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Day 3**Scenic Journey to Ha Long Bay & Overnight Cruise***Meals: B,L,D | Stay: Capella Cruise | Transport: Limousine bus, cruise boat*

In the morning, a driver will collect you from your hotel for a scenic journey towards Ha Long Bay, an estimated 2.5-hour drive. Upon arrival, you'll proceed to the Capella Cruise Lounge for check-in procedures before boarding your luxury cruise vessel. A warm welcome drink awaits as you settle into your cabin.

Lunch will be served as the cruise begins its gentle navigation through the breathtaking seascape of thousands of limestone karsts and islets. In the afternoon, the adventure continues with an exploration of Sung Sot Cave (Surprise Cave), one of the bay's most magnificent grottoes, featuring impressive stalactites and stalagmites. As evening approaches, enjoy a stunning sunset from the sundeck during happy hour. A delectable dinner will be served in the onboard restaurant, followed by free time to relax and enjoy the serene atmosphere of the bay.

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Day 4**Ha Long Bay Sunrise, Hanoi Street Food & Overnight Train**

Meals: B,L | Stay: Night train Hanoi – Lao Cai | Transport: Cruise boat, bamboo boat, limousine bus, private car, night train

Start your day early with the opportunity to witness a spectacular sunrise over Ha Long Bay, followed by an optional meditation session on the sundeck. A light breakfast will be served before you embark on a bamboo boat excursion to explore the hidden beauty of Luon Cave, a tranquil lagoon accessible through a narrow archway. Afterwards, return to the cruise for a generous brunch buffet.

Following brunch, you'll check out from your cabin and disembark at the Capella Cruise Waiting Lounge, where your transfer back to Hanoi awaits. Arriving in Hanoi in the afternoon, you'll have some free time before embarking on a culinary adventure in the Old Quarter. At 5:00 PM, a guide will meet you for a street food tour, starting at the famous Bia Hoi Corner to sample the local draft beer.

Continue through the bustling narrow streets, where your guide will introduce you to a variety of tasty noodles, breads, and snacks from sidewalk vendors. Experience the lively evening atmosphere as locals gather on stools around sizzling woks for an authentic flame-grilled Vietnamese barbecue. The gastronomic journey concludes with dessert at Hanoi's renowned ice-cream parlor. Later, at 9:00 PM, you will be transferred to the train station to catch the 10:00 PM night train to Lao Cai, settling into a comfortable 4-bed cabin for your overnight journey.

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Day 5**Sapa Arrival & Fansipan Mountain Ascent***Meals: B | Stay: Topas Ecolodge | Transport: Private car, cable car*

Your train will arrive in Lao Cai around 6:00 AM, where you'll be met and transferred by car for a 45-minute drive to Sapa. Upon arrival, enjoy breakfast at a local restaurant and take some time to rest before your morning adventure. Today's highlight is a cable car ride to the summit of Fansipan Mountain, known as the 'Roof of Indochina.'

As you ascend, marvel at the stunning natural scenery, including the majestic Hoang Lien Son mountain range and the picturesque Muong Hoa Valley, often shrouded in a ethereal mist. Once at the cable car station, prepare for a climb of 600 stone steps to reach the very top of Fansipan for unparalleled panoramic views. After soaking in the incredible vistas, you'll take the cable car back down to Sapa town and then transfer to the charming Topas Ecolodge for your overnight stay, offering a peaceful retreat amidst the mountains.

Day 6**Red Dao Village Trek & Return to Hanoi***Meals: B | Stay: Peridot Grand Luxury hotel | Transport: Walking, limousine bus*

After breakfast at your ecolodge, begin a picturesque walk from Topas Ecolodge along a quiet road, offering magnificent views of the terraced rice fields below. The path gradually ascends towards Lech village, where you'll have the opportunity to visit a local Red Dao house. Here, you'll meet friendly villagers and gain insight into their daily lives and unique cultural practices. The Red Dao women are notable for their distinct customs, including shaved hair and eyebrows, and their vibrant, intricately embroidered traditional clothing. They are also renowned for their skilled handmade embroidery and basket weaving. During your visit, you may also stop by the village school to learn about the education system in Vietnam's northern mountains. The return journey to Topas Ecolodge involves walking along smaller trails that wind through more rice terraces and cross a charming suspension bridge. Your guide will share fascinating details about the local farmers' cultivating techniques and their deep connection to the land. After returning to the ecolodge around noon, you'll have free time until 2:30 PM, when a Topas limousine bus will transfer you back to Hanoi. You will be dropped off at your Hanoi hotel around 8:00 PM.

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Day 7**Flight to Hue & Romantic Hillside Dinner***Meals: B,D | Stay: aNhill Boutique | Transport: Private car, domestic flight*

In the afternoon, a private car will transfer you to Noi Bai Airport for your 1 hour and 20 minute domestic flight from Hanoi to Hue. Upon arrival at Hue airport, a driver will meet you and provide a transfer to the AnHill Hotel for check-in. You'll then have some free time to settle in and relax.

As evening descends, prepare for a special romantic experience. Begin with an aperitif, enjoying the breathtaking sunset views over the surrounding hills. As candlelight illuminates the tranquil Koi pond, you will be treated to a custom-designed dinner for two. This exquisite meal features decadent ingredients and local specialties, expertly prepared by the hotel's chef, creating a truly memorable dining occasion.

The day starts with a visit to the Hue Imperial Citadel, the magnificent former home of Vietnam's last royal dynasty, the Nguyen Dynasty. Wander through its impressive gates, palaces, and temples, learning about the rich history of imperial Vietnam. After a delicious lunch at a local restaurant, you'll embark on a serene boat trip along the Perfume River.

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Day 11**Flight to Ho Chi Minh City & Cu Chi Tunnels by Speedboat***Meals: B,L | Stay: New World Saigon hotel | Transport: Private car, domestic flight, speed boat*

Early this morning, at 6:15 AM, you will be transferred to Danang airport for a 1 hour and 30 minute flight to Ho Chi Minh City. Upon arrival, a driver will pick you up and transfer you to your hotel for a short period of rest. Around 11:00 AM, you will be collected again for an exciting excursion to the Cu Chi Tunnels by speedboat.

Traveling by speedboat offers a unique perspective of the city's waterways before reaching the tunnel complex. Once at the Cu Chi Tunnels, you'll have the opportunity to explore this intricate network of underground passageways, famously used by the Viet Cong during various conflicts. Your knowledgeable guide will explain the communication routes, supply lines, hospitals, and living quarters within the tunnels. A highlight of the tour is the chance to crawl through a section of the tunnels yourself, providing a firsthand sense of the soldiers' experiences. After exploring, enjoy a delicious traditional Vietnamese lunch featuring local specialties like lemongrass chicken and caramelized clay pot pork. You will spend the night in Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 12**Ho Chi Minh City Historical Landmarks Tour***Meals: B,L | Stay: New World Saigon hotel | Transport: Private car*

Today features a comprehensive city excursion to visit Ho Chi Minh City's most prominent historical landmarks. Your first stop is the Reunification Hall, formerly known as the Presidential Palace, a site of immense historical significance as it was here that North Vietnamese tanks famously breached the gates on April 30, 1975, marking the fall of Saigon. This fascinating building is preserved with much of its original decor and provides a vivid insight into a pivotal moment in Vietnamese history.

From there, you'll enjoy a leisurely stroll to explore major sights from the city's colonial past. These include the grand Old Saigon Post Office, a beautiful example of French colonial architecture; Dong Khoi Street, once known as Rue Catinat; the historic Continental Hotel; the elegant Opera House; and the impressive City Hall. After the tour, you will be transferred back to your hotel, with the remainder of the day at leisure to relax or explore further independently.

At 8:00 AM, you'll depart Ho Chi Minh City, navigating through the morning traffic for a two-hour drive to the Mekong Delta. Arriving in Ben Tre around 10:00 AM, you will immediately board a boat for a pleasant cruise along the Ham Luong River. The journey will proceed at a relaxed pace, including several stops to discover traditional local crafts and industries that have been passed down through generations, with practices remaining largely intact. This offers a genuine glimpse into the region's heritage.

To conclude the morning's activities and prepare for a slightly later lunch, you'll hop on bicycles for a leisurely ride through lush forests and verdant orchards. This scenic route leads to a charming riverside restaurant, where you'll be treated to typical Mekong Delta cuisine. You'll even have the chance to try your hand at preparing a local dish, such as
