Begin your day with a scenic 2.5-hour drive from Hanoi to Ha Long Bay. Upon arrival at the harbor, the friendly staff of Sealife Cruise will welcome you at the waiting room. You will then embark on your deluxe cruiser and check into your private cabin. A refreshing welcome drink awaits as your vessel sets sail, offering a delicious lunch while navigating among the bay's iconic limestone islets.

The afternoon's activities include exploring Hon Co Island and the stunning Thien Canh Son Cave (also known as Co Cave or Grass Cave). After discovering the cave's formations, you can unwind on the island's long, white sandy beach, enjoy a swim, and take in the breathtaking views of Bai Tu Long Bay. The cruise will then proceed to the Cong Do sleeping area. Relax before enjoying dinner on board. Take advantage of Happy Hour specials from 4:30 PM to 7:00 PM, with discounts on cocktails, mocktails, and mixed drinks. The drive offers captivating scenery, especially as you descend into the valleys surrounding Mai Chau, providing excellent photographic opportunities. Upon arrival, the program offers flexibility, allowing for light trekking or cycling through the stunning landscapes. You will have ample opportunities to visit several minority tribe villages, explore local caves, or simply relax amidst one of Vietnam's most scenic regions. Your guide can discuss alternative activities to suit your preferences. In the evening, immerse yourself in local culture with traditional dances performed by the indigenous Thái tribe people. Your overnight stay will be at a homestay with a Thái family, offering an authentic cultural experience.

In the early afternoon, you will depart east towards Ninh Binh, Vietnam's former capital, once known as Hoa Lu. The journey takes approximately four hours, but the time passes quickly as you begin to witness the towering limestone karsts that define this region, earning it the nickname 'Halong on Land'. Upon arrival, you will check into your accommodation for an overnight stay in Ninh Binh.

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continue your cycling adventure to the serene Bich Dong Pagoda, nestled into a mountainside. Your day concludes with an overnight stay back in Ninh Binh.

Marvel at its grand scale and architectural prowess, constructed using approximately 20,000 cubic meters of rock and nearly 100,000 cubic meters of soil. This historical site offers a glimpse into Vietnam's ancient royal power and sophisticated engineering. Your day concludes with an overnight stay in Dong Hoi City.

These impressive structures, built between the 7th and 13th centuries, are considered comparable to other great archaeological sites in Southeast Asia, such as Angkor in Cambodia and Bagan in Myanmar.

After exploring the historical ruins, return to Hoi An for lunch at a local restaurant. The afternoon is dedicated to discovering the tranquility and charm of Hoi An Town. Wander through its streets lined with low-tiled houses of Chinese influence, admire the iconic Japanese covered bridge, and visit brightly painted temples and pagodas. Hoi An's unique blend of architectural styles makes it one of Vietnam's most delightful destinations. You will spend another night in Hoi An.

Day 16**Pleiku to Buon Ma Thuot & Ho Chi Minh Trail Scenery**

This morning, depart from Pleiku and travel towards Buon Ma Thuot, following a section of the historic Ho Chi Minh Trail, which runs along the border with Cambodia. En route, you will make a stop to visit the impressive Drei Sap Waterfalls, where you can admire the powerful cascades and lush surroundings.
