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Day 2

Hanoi Historical & Cultural Exploration

Next, you'll visit the One Pillar Pagoda, a distinctive Buddhist temple renowned for its lotus-flower design, dating back to the Ly dynasty. The journey continues to the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, where you can pay respects to the revered figure of modern Vietnam (viewed from outside; closed on Mondays, Fridays, and from June to August). Conclude your historical exploration at the picturesque West Lake and the ancient Tran Quoc Buddhist Pagoda, a sixth-century marvel and Hanoi's oldest pagoda with a history spanning over 1,500 years. A delicious Vietnamese meal at a local restaurant is included before returning to your hotel.

The evening is yours to enjoy as you wish. You might choose to unwind at the hotel or venture out for further independent discovery of Hanoi's dynamic urban environment.

Day 3

Around 3:30 PM, the return journey to Hanoi begins, offering one last chance to appreciate the scenic countryside views.
