For those interested, a shooting range offers the chance to fire real bullets with a selection of guns (additional fee applies). A light lunch will be served at a local restaurant with your group before returning to Ho Chi Minh City.

The afternoon is dedicated to exploring the top must-visit sights of Ho Chi Minh City. Your first stop is the Independence Palace, where the Vietnamese Revolutionary Army achieved victory in 1975. This significant national monument houses many historical displays and the former living residences of South Vietnamese President Nguyen Van Thieu. After approximately 1.5 hours of exploration, proceed to the Saigon Notre Dame Cathedral and Central Post Office, both iconic landmarks showcasing excellent examples of French colonial architecture. (Note: Notre Dame Cathedral is under renovation until 2027, with visits limited to its surroundings).

Continue your historical journey at the War Remnants Museum, which offers a poignant look at the First Indochina War and the Vietnam War through powerful exhibits illustrating the futility and harsh impacts of conflict, including an American F5A jet fighter. The sightseeing trip concludes with a drop-off at your hotel, leaving your evening free to discover the city's nightlife at your leisure.
