Day 1**Ho Chi Minh City Arrival**

Meals: NA | Stay: Hotel in Ho Chi Minh | Transport: Private car

Upon your arrival at Tan Son Nhat Airport in Ho Chi Minh City, often still referred to as Saigon by locals, you will be warmly greeted by your tour guide and driver. A private car will transfer you to your hotel for check-in. Please note that the standard check-in time is 2:00 PM; early check-in can be arranged with an additional surcharge.

For those eager to start exploring, the afternoon and evening are free for you to discover the vibrant city at your own pace. You might consider optional activities such as the 'A O Show Saigon' for a cultural performance or a 'Saigon Night Life Tour by Motorbike' to experience the city's evening energy.

Day 2**Saigon Half-Day City Tour by Motorbike**

Meals: Breakfast | Stay: Hotel in Ho Chi Minh City | Transport: Motorbike

Choose a morning (8:00 AM - 8:30 AM) or afternoon (1:00 PM - 1:30 PM) departure for a half-day city tour by motorbike, offering a unique perspective of Ho Chi Minh City. Your ride will take you past iconic landmarks such as the Notre Dame Cathedral and Central Post Office, both showcasing stunning French colonial architecture and intricate Gothic styling. While the Cathedral is currently undergoing renovation, you can still admire its exterior. You'll also see the Saigon Opera House, an architectural gem reflecting Vietnam's colonial history.

Continue to the Ho Chi Minh City People's Committee Head Office and stroll along Nguyen Hue Walking Street, known for its apartment cafes offering great photo opportunities. The tour also includes visits to hidden city gems like the venerable Thich Quang Duc monument, Ho Thi Ky flower market, Thien Hau Pagoda, and the Cambodian market.

The journey concludes with a visit to Nguyen Thien Thuat Oldest Apartment, a famous street food area where you can observe local life. Afterward, you will be driven back to your hotel, passing Nguyen Trai Street in District 5, renowned for its fashion shops. The rest of the day is free for your independent exploration.

Day 3

Explore Mekong Delta and Tan Phong Island

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Stay: Mekong Eco-lodge | Transport: Car, small rowing boat

After breakfast, depart at 8:00 AM for Cai Be. Your first stop is the Com Candy Craft Village, where you can observe the process of making candy nuggets and sample freshly baked sweets. Next, visit a bee farm to enjoy fresh honey tea and witness the daily life of local people amidst the gardens.

Continue to Tan Phong Islet for garden tourism, where you can enjoy unique tropical fruits like durian, rambutan, and longan (seasonal) and even pick them yourself. At a local house, you'll be treated to a live performance of 'Don Ca Tai Tu', a traditional Vietnamese folk music, accompanied by tea and welcome fruits.

Board a small rowing boat to navigate through narrow canals to Mekong Ecolodge for check-in, followed by lunch at a local restaurant. The afternoon offers time to relax, explore the fruit and flower gardens of the Ecolodge, and pick fruits directly from the trees. Later, participate in 'ditch fishing hook', a traditional local activity, using a traditional fishing tool to catch fish. You'll then gather vegetables from the garden to help prepare dinner with the homestay's local chef. Enjoy your dinner and spend the night at the homestay.

Activities: Craft village visit, bee farm visit, fruit picking, folk music performance, rowing boat, ditch fishing, cooking class

Day 4

Tan Phong Island Cycling, Handicrafts & Flight to Da Nang

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Hoi An | Transport: Bicycle, ferry, car, airplane

Begin your day with the fresh air and sounds of the countryside. Take a morning stroll around the village to observe local farmers' activities. After breakfast at your homestay, join a cycling tour around Tan Phong Island. You'll visit traditional handicraft workshops, witnessing locals making rice papers and learning how to knit banana hammocks and water hyacinth products. You can even try knitting yourself. The tour also includes seeing the process of making nail files with bamboo sticks and local materials.

Cycle back to the Ecolodge for a cooking class where you'll learn to make jackfruit leaf cake, a specialty of Tan Phong Island, and then enjoy your creation. After checking out, you'll travel from Tan Phong ferry with locals to Hiep Duc, where your driver will pick you up and transfer you to the airport for your flight to Da Nang. Lunch will be provided midway during your return journey to Ho Chi Minh City.

Upon arrival at Da Nang Airport, you'll be transferred to your hotel in Hoi An. The rest of the day is yours to relax and recover or explore the enchanting streets of Hoi An by night.

Day 5**Free Day in Hoi An & Evening Street Food Tour**

You'll have the chance to try plowing and raking with buffalo, transplanting rice, flood farming, and grinding and pounding rice with assistance from the host family. For a unique photo opportunity, you can even try riding a water buffalo.

Afterward, head to a local fishing village to try fishing alongside professional fishermen. The tour concludes with a memorable basket boat trip, allowing you to explore the lush water coconut jungle. A delicious lunch will be served at a local house before you finish the trip. The afternoon is free for you to return to your hotel and rest after an active day.

Perfume River Cruise, Thien Mu Pagoda & Hue Cooking Class

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Hue | Transport: Dragon boat

Your day begins with a unique dragon boat ride from Toa Kham Wharf, offering a serene journey along the Perfume River and a glimpse into Hue's tranquil lifestyle. The boat will make a stop at Thien Mu Pagoda, one of the city's most ancient shrines, known for its seven-story brick pagoda, lush gardens, and peaceful atmosphere.

After your visit, you'll return to the dragon boat and head to Hue Ecologde, where your guide will lead you to Thuy Bieu Eco-village. This relaxing village is celebrated for its serenity, abundant fruit gardens, and traditional houses, providing a rejuvenating experience. You'll have time to stroll or cycle around the village, visiting local handicraft families to learn about their lifestyle, including incense-making and paper painting.

Later, participate in a cooking class at Hue Ecologde, where you'll learn to prepare authentic Hue cuisine, such as Vietnamese traditional spring rolls and Banh Khoai. Enjoy the delicious dishes you've created, with feedback and advice from the Eco-chef. The tour concludes with a relaxing foot soak in hot water infused with medical herbs and an excellent massage by blind therapists.

This evening, you'll join an exciting street food walking tour to savor authentic Vietnamese dishes. Stroll through the sparkling Hanoi Old Quarter and try soup-based delicacies like Pho Bo (Vietnamese Beef Noodles), Bun Thang (Rice Vermicelli Noodles With Chicken And Eggs), or Bun Bo Hue. Continue your walk with Banh Cuon (Steamed Rice Rolls) and Banh Mi.

Sample local snacks such as Nom Bo Kho (Dried Beef Salad) and Nem Chua Ran (Fried Fermented Pork Roll). Round off your culinary journey with Ca Phe Trung, the famous Egg Coffee, a unique Hanoi specialty. After a delightful evening, return to your hotel to relax.

Hanoi Half-Day City Tour by Motorbike

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch | Stay: Hotel in Hanoi | Transport: Motorbike

At 8:00 AM, meet your tour guide at the hotel to begin a half-day motorbike tour exploring Hanoi's famous sites. You'll start by seeing Long Bien Bridge and the nearby Chuong Duong Bridge, enjoy some famous Trang Tien ice cream, and pass by the Hanoi Opera House, a venue for many art performances.

Visit the beautiful Hoan Kiem Lake, a signature destination in Hanoi, located near the Ly Thai To Monument. Continue to Hoa Lo Prison, also known as Maison Centrale, to learn about its historical significance. Travel to West Lake, Hanoi's largest freshwater lake, where you'll find Tran Quoc Pagoda, the oldest Buddhist temple in Vietnam, situated on a small island.

The tour also includes a visit to Huu Tiep Lake – B52 crash site, commemorating a victory in the Vietnam War. From here, your guide will take you to a nearby market to observe local daily life. The tour concludes with a trip to Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, where you can admire the exterior and take pictures (note: the mausoleum is viewed from outside, closed on Monday & Friday, and from June to August). Before returning to your hotel, enjoy tasty Vietnamese food at a nearby restaurant.

The afternoon is free for you to relax or discover more of Hanoi through optional tours such as a cooking class or a pottery adventure.

Activities: Motorbike tour, sightseeing, market visit, mausoleum viewing, lunch

Day 12

Halong Bay Cruise & Overnight Onboard

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner | Stay: Cruise in Halong Bay | Transport: Car, cruise

After breakfast at your hotel, your driver will pick you up at 8:00 AM for the journey to Halong Bay. Arrive at the port and prepare to board your cruise between 11:30 AM and 12:00 PM to begin your exploration of the majestic Halong Bay.
